 To the Hon. E. B. Lancaster Esq. Judge Midland Co.
 & Hon. Es. Commissioners. Gentlemen,
 we herewith file a true record of the field
 notes of Midland Es. together with the notes of
 Lawrence, beginning on N. W. corner of Coleman
 Es. per order of Commissioners, of the General
 Land Office, and per order of the Hon. Co. Court
 of Midland Es. Beginning a large stone
 monument about two feet high standing
 in a valley surrounded by low hills, and
 no prominent object in sight upon which
 to take bearings, this stone is lettered N. W.
 Cor. E. Es. 30 M. on east side and lettered
 N. E. Cor. R. Es. on the west side marked 1585
 on each side. Thence due west 30 miles
 to a point the N. E. Cor. of Tom Green Co. estab-
 lished & marked, as follows, a large stone
 monument 30 inches high standing near
 a cedar knoll from which the west point
 of a mountain bears N. $47\frac{1}{4}$ W. the east
 point of another mountain bears N. $22\frac{1}{2}$ E.
 a bushy top mountain bears S. $71\frac{1}{2}$ E. a
 small rough red rock knoll bears S.
 $35\frac{1}{2}$ W. This monument is lettered N. E. Cor
 T. G. Es. on the south side. Thence 300 varas West
 to a point from which the N. W. cor. H. C. Royce
 preemption bears due N. 140 varas. Thence 1600
