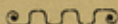
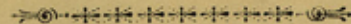

Whereas Midland County has surveyed its boundary lines and that in surveying their north boundary line, Midland County encroached on Martin County for a distance of about one mile along the entire south side of Martin County from N.E. Cor. of Midland County to S.W. Cor. of Martin County, and whereas Midland County failed to give notice to Martin County that they would make a survey of their boundary lines, and whereas; the starting or beginning point from which to survey the boundary lines of Martin County was never established thereby making it difficult and possibly impossible to correctly establish the boundary lines of this, Martin, County; therefore the Commissioners Court of Martin County hereby protests against the approval of said Midland County boundary lines, by the Hon. Charles Rogan Commissioner of the General Land Office of the State of Texas, and the Co. Clk. is hereby instructed to forward a copy of this protest to said Hon. Charles Rogan Com.G.L.O.
