3 Whereas at a special
4 term of the Commissioners Court of
5 Milam County Texas held on the 18th
6 day of July A. D. 1892, an order was pas-
7 -sed to have the boundary line of
8 Milam County more definitely defined,
9 and J. P. Looney, County surveyor of
10 Milam County Tex. was appointed to
11 survey and define said line and to
12 make connection with the original
13 and individual survey through
14 which said line runs, with such
15 other surveyor as might be appoint-
16 -ed by the Commissioners Court of
17 the adjoining Counties. And whereas
18 Lee County was properly notified
19 of the action of Milam County, and
20 did at the term of the Com. Court
21 appoint A. J. Vetter, County surveyor
22 of Lee County and as Milam and
23 Burleson Counties line was to be
24 also surveyed, and as Lee County
25 cornered with the corner of Burles-
26 -on county and as the beginning
27 corner of Milam is on the N. E. Cor-
28 -ner of the H. E. Davis League on the
29 west bank of the Brazos River, and
30 A. J. Vetter with J. P. Looney of Milam
31 Co. and J. D. Dalrymple of Burleson
32 did on the 12th day of Sept. 1892.
33 meet at Yellow Prairie, Burleson Co.
34 Texas, and from there on went to the

1 N. E. Corner of the H. E. Davis League,
2 and did run with our old blazed
3 line S. 60 W. with the north line of
4 said H. E. Davis League, with a mag-
5 -netic variation of 8°-45' E. which we
6 ran through to the Williamson Co^s
7 East line.

8 We found the old blazed line all
9 the way, on the old timber. - We then
10 went to the S. E. Corner of the Thos. A.
11 Grove League, known as the "Pact
12 Cat Island" survey & ran back N. 71 E.
13 8 miles and we find the old blazed
14 line to be the old Burlington and
15 Milan Co. line which we accept as
16 true line between Milan & Lin Co^s
17 which is as follows, to wit: -

18 Begin at the N. W. Corner of Bur-
19 -lerson County in the center of Yegua
20 Creek, we set a cedar Post on the west
21 bank of said Yegua from which a
22 Pin Oak marked T. B. M. bearing N. 30. W. 15⁰⁰ 2
23 and Elm 15 in. in dia. marked bearing N. 22 W.
24 13⁰⁰ vs. Thence S. 60 W. at 200 vs. leave
25 Bottom at 275 vs. old road, at 1060 vs.
26 road at 1330 vs. Branch at 1900 vs.
27 1st mile post at 1 mile 160 vs. Large
28 Ravine at 180 vs. cross the south line
29 of the Wm Pharrace - N. 71 E. 2100 vs from

We find the N.E. Cor of Lee
Co. as made by R. E. Harris survey
or of Lee Co Texas to be 300 vs. N. 19° W
from the old blazed line we
traced the line from thence
S 61° 30' W. to another corner on the
N.E. line of the Richard Ross sur-
vey 720 vs. N. 19° W. from the old
line we traced and from thence
the said Harris line runs S 58° W.
to another point for the S.E. Cor.
of Williamson Co. 132 vs. N. 19° W. from
the old blazed line we traced
the number 15th 1892.
