On this the 10th day of August 1897 came on to be
heard the report of John P. Leouey - County Surveyor
of Milam County - who at a former term of this
Court was appointed to make a Survey of the Bound-
ary between Falls & Milam Counties, and also
a Survey of the Boundary between Bell and
Milam Counties, which said report being in-
spected by the court ^{as} found correct is ap-
proved and ordered to be recorded on the
minutes of this Court ^{as} is as follows, to wit:
The State of Texas Boundary Line Between Falls & Milam Co.
County of Milam Whereas at a special term of the Non-
Commissioners Court of Milam County, Texas, held on
the 18th day of February AD 1897, an order was
passed to have the boundaries of Milam County
more definitely defined and J. P. Leouey, County Surveyor
of Milam County was appointed to survey and
define make connections with the original and
individual surveys through which said line passed
with such other Surveyors as might be appointed
by the other County Commissioners adjoining Milam
County and Falls County was properly notified of the
action of the Commissioners of Milam County and
did at their May term of Court appoint Robt S.
Kuunicutt, County Surveyor of Falls County Texas, to
meet J. P. Leouey of Milam County, and the 25th
day of July 1897 was set to meet at the S. E. corner
of Bell County, and at the appointed time ^{as} place
the Surveyors Leouey ^{and} Kuunicutt met and
proceeded upon their duties as follows, to wit:
We began and ran a line with the compass to
the Samuel Frost N. W. Cor. we ran on the North line
of the Samuel Frost League about 4 miles ^{and} finding
the running of same we retraced same to N. W. Cor.

where we found old bearings, a huckleberry N. 87 W.
 1 vrs. still standing and alive, an Elm falling down
 2 stump Lrs. N. 17 E. which are the calls for the origi-
 3 nal cor. which is 10445 mrs. from the N. E. cor. on
 4 Brazos River and is in Little Brush Creek bottom.
 From this point we ran a transit line S. 60 W.
 1 with a magnetic variation of $9^{\circ}30' E.$ at 65 mrs.
 2 the bed of Brush Creek - at 175 mrs. leaves bottom
 3 at 150 mrs. enters small branch 20 mrs. above its
 4 mouth. and leaves same at 230 mrs. on right.
 At 955 mrs. set the 6th mile post. At 6 miles 240
 1 mrs. cross the bed of Big Brush 3 mrs. below the
 2 mouth of a small branch. at 731 mrs. enter Brush
 3 and leaves same at 365 mrs. At mouth of small
 4 branch from the West and left branch 407 mrs.
 At 840 mrs. cross Land N. 30 W. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ mrs. from the
 1 lower line of Pawnee pasture on S. line of the Brew-
 2 ster Lea. At 1693 mrs. a bed of branch. At 7 miles
 3 set a post from which a very large p. o. marked
 4 McLean S. 77 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ mrs. - Ditto 15 in. in dia.
 marked F. bs. S. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ mrs. At 7 miles 100 mrs.
 the Kiaman & Brewster line 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ mrs. from the S. E.
 1 cor. of Kiaman - At 1191 mrs. bed of small branch
 2 at 1340 mrs. bed of Moore branch - at 1896 mrs.
 3 small branch - We mark Elm with 8 notches for the
 4 8th mile post. - At 8 miles 28 mrs. bed of large
 branch - At 1765 mrs. bed of small branch - course
 about S. 40 \circ E. at 9 miles 33 mrs. we cut off a
 mesquite and marked it for the 9th mile post. At 30
 1 mrs. enter the Gilbert Lake and cross it at 365 mrs.-
 At 767 mrs. the E. bank of Big Pond creek and
 cross it at 783 mrs. At 1788 mrs. cross the S. W.
 1 line of the Kiaman League of 30 E. 145 mrs. from
 the N. E. cor. of the G. B. Erath 1780 acre Survey.

At 1,470 m.s. cross the bed of a ravine - at 1815
m.s. a large forked mesquite tree lone ^{is} off 10th
mile is S. 60 W. 85 m.s. from the mesquite tree which
is marked for mile post. At 819 m.s. cross a lane
and road through the G.B. Erath survey. Course S.
45 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. At 1791 ~~meters~~ little pond cross - at
1811 m.s. West bank of same. At 11 miles we flag &
and have an Elm tree - At 11 miles 911 m.s. cross
the West line of G.B. Erath ^{and} East line of the
J. Zeller original survey, 165 m.s. S. 30 E. from
the corner of same. - At 951 m.s. the center of the
S.A. & A.P. Ry. N. 6° W. 1158 varas from Burlington
Station - at 997 m.s. branch, course about
North - At 1697 m.s. line between Pat Dillon and
Nagerty - At 1700 m.s. large branch, course about
N 20 E. At 17 miles we stopped and marked the
mesquite stump for the 17" mile post. - At 17 miles
518 varas. cross line between O'Neil ^{and} Nagerty -
At 1733 m.s. West line of the Zellers S. 30 E. 165 m.s.
from the N. W. cor. of same. - At 13 miles in bed
of a branch we mark an Elm with 13 hacks. - At
13 miles 51 m.s. bed of branch - At 1150 m.s. line be-
tween the Bowers and Brown Survey. S. 30 E. 157
m.s. from the N. W. cor. of the Bowers league and 357
m.s. from the N.E. cor. of the Browns. - At 14 miles
marked a mesquite for the 14" mile post. At 14
miles 240 m.s. enter Mustang Creek and leave
it 277 m.s. on same side and cross it at 380 m.s.
At 455 m.s. cross the line between Glasson and Sch-
neider N. 30° W. 914 m.s. from Glasson's S. W. cor. - At
1600 m.s. West fence of Mustang Creek. - At 15 miles
set a cedar post at 10 m.s. in line with the West
of the Shepards. - At 40 m.s. a lane between Klin-
Kleman and Schneider and claimed to be the East

1 Line of the Eaves Survey. - At 16 miles the West
2 line of ^{the} Eaves and East line of the Joseph H.
3 Clark $\frac{1}{3}$ league Survey. S. 30 E. 320 rods from the
4 N.E. cor. of the Clark $\frac{1}{3}$ League. - At 16 miles 6 $\frac{1}{4}$
5 rods. a branch - at 966 rods. the S.E. corner of Bell
6 and N.W. corner of Falls County. a cedar post
7 set from which an Elm marked F hrs. S. 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ W.
8 73 rods. and a mesquite marked C hrs. S. 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ W.
9 69 rods. and a double p. o. marked F hrs. N. 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.
10 56 $\frac{3}{5}$ rods.

16 The State of Texas
17 County of Milam & Whereas at the special February
18 term of the Commissioners Court of Milam County
19 held in Cameron, Milam County, Texas, on the 18th
20 day of February, 1897, an order was passed to
21 have the boundaries of Milam County more de-
22 finitely defined, and J. P. Cooney, County Surveyor
23 for Milam County, was appointed to survey said
24 lines with such other surveyors as might be ap-
25 pointed by the several other counties joining
26 and whereas Bell County, was properly notified
27 of the action of the said Court of Milam County
28 and at their regular May term of the Bell County
29 Commissioners Court, Ed. F. Rucker, a competent
30 Surveyor from Bell County, was appointed to meet
31 said J. P. Cooney from Milam County, and the
32 31st day of May A.D. 1897 was set and agreed

on by said Surveyors to meet at Davilla
Milam County for the purpose of beginning
said work, and at the time and place mentioned
said Surveyors J. P. Society from Milam County and
Ed. F. Rucker from Bell County met at Davilla
Texas. --- We then went to the Williamson County
line - the cor. set by Peter Rucker in 1880, which
we found 95 yrs N. 20° E. from the Williamson
County line - From whence we ran N. 19 E. about
400 yrs. Alligator Creek, at 1900 yrs we set the
first mile post. - At one mile 1100 yrs. Mrs. Charles
Fowler's South line. N. 71 W. 1470 yrs. from her S. E.
cor. at 7 miles we set a post. - At 7 miles 930
yrs. the N. line of Mrs. Chas. Fowler's and South
line of James Stevens tract, S. 71 E. 1750 yrs. from
the S. W. cor. of said Stevens tract - at 1740 yrs.
the S. E. cor. of the Jesse Munford League - at
1900 yrs the 3rd mile post. - at 1900 yrs the 4th
mile on the side of a hill - at 4 miles 1470 yrs.
Dowahoe Creek 35 yrs wide. - Running S. E. at 5
miles in James Whittington's field at 1900 yrs.
6th mile - at 1900, 7th mile in H. D. Mathews
field - at 1900 yrs 8" mile - at 8 miles 183.5 yrs.
the South bank of Little River, at a bend of said
river where the line crosses the river three times -
at 8 miles 187.5 yrs. the North bank of Little River -
at 1900 yrs. 9th mile - at 9 miles 75 yrs. the bank
of Little River the second time - at 130 yrs the op-
posite bank of said river 375 yrs. the river - at 475
yrs. the N. bank of Little River, N. 71 W. 24 yrs. from
the E. line of J. R. Graddock's tract and on a line
line N. 71 W. 3700 yrs from the line of Arocha
Grant - We ran thence N. 19 E. at 1145 from
river, Graddock's N. E. corner - at 1675 yrs set a

Stake in a ravine for a cor. between Milam and
 Bell Counties. - We ran thence N. 60° E. at 10.50 mrs.
 14th mile post - at 1900 mrs. 13th mile post - 1900
 mrs 17th mil. - at 7.50 mrs the E. line of the Arrochar
 and W. line of the Sauches as settled by a decree
 of Dist. Court (which is 5000 mrs. N. 60° E. from
 cor. of Milam & Bell Counties) and 7th 7.5 mrs. N.
 20° E. from the cor. on Little river - At 1900 mrs 11th
 mile post - At 1700 mrs. the G. O. & S. T. RR, bear-
 ing N. 65° W. at crossing - At 1900 mrs. 10th mile post.
 At 1900 mrs 9th mile post - At 1900 mrs. 8th mile post.
 At 10.50 mrs the E. line of the Sauches and the West
 line of the DePena's 11 Leagues grant - S. 20° W.
 310 mrs. from South Elm or Cow Creek and N. 20° E.
 17890 mrs. from the river - at 1900 mrs. 7th mile post.
 At 13.60 mrs. the West line of the Henry Pardon League
 N. 20° E. & 8.5 mrs. from the S. W. corner near Cow
 Creek or South Elm Creek - at 1900 mrs. 6th mile post -
 at 1900 mrs. 5 mile post = at 360 mrs. Big Elm creek
 runs East = at 1740 mrs. the East line of Pardon on
 West line of Joseph H. Clark 640 acre Survey -
 S. 19° W. 1100 mrs. from Pardon's N. E. cor. and Clark
 N. W. cor. at 1900 mrs. 10th mile post = At 170 mrs. Hil-
 low Branch - at 1780 mrs. the North line of the Joseph
 Clark on South line of the J. M. Lemons - N. E. W.
 765 mrs. from the N. E. cor. of Joseph H. Clark 640 acre
 Survey - At 1900 mrs. 3rd mile post - at 1018 mrs. the
 W. line of the Joseph H. Clark $\frac{1}{3}$ lea, 1870 mrs. N. 30°
 W. from the cor. with Lemons. on the Bradford N.
 line - at 1900 mrs. 7th mile - at 960 mrs. the
 cor. of Bell and Falls Counties as set by Henni-
 cutt - This point on a parallel line S. 30° E. 308
 mrs from the S. W. cor. of the Shepard Survey -
 We ran this line with a magnetic variation of

q^o with a transit and cut it out clear of
obstructions except on the Jessy Mumford East
line which is the Co. line. - This we ran with
the compass only - all the rest we ran with the
compass and then with a transit discarding
the needle. We have also made connections
with all the individual surveys of which we
herewith hand to the K. A. Commissioners Courts
of both Milam ^{and} Bell counties, maps. We also
make a map showing all the original surveys
to the general Land Office at Austin.

We submit by way of explanation the following
mile posts are numbered from Williamson
County line to the Co. on the line where the line
runs N. 60 E. and from the Falls Co. line are also
numbered to said Co.
