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On motion of Commissioner Brookshire  
the following supplemental report of the  
survey of the county line between William-  
son and Milam counties was adopted  
as the true line between said counties  
to-wit:—

Beginning, at the S.W. corner of Milam  
as located by W. M. Jamie of Milam and A. S.  
Howren of Williamson, in 1890, which is N 71 E,  
14,950 vrs from the West line of the Swearingan survey  
Thence, we run N 19 W, at 14,460 vrs, crosses the South  
line of the Geo Deery survey N 71 E, 3,440 vrs from  
its cor. on the S.E. line of the Henry Cook survey; at 18,940  
vrs cross the S.E. line of the Henry Cook survey S 19 W 14,460  
vrs from its N.E. cor. at 19,000 vrs, first mile post—at  
37,040 vrs cross the N line of the Henry Cook survey  
N 71 W, 11,000 vrs from the N.E. cor. of same—at 47,749 vrs  
crosses the N line of the Geo Deery survey, N 71 E, 9,430 vrs  
from cor. on the Harrison Owen S line—at 58,610 vrs  
cross the S. line of the Harrison Owen survey N 19 E  
17,300 vrs from the S.E. cor of same—at 100,900 vrs, cross  
the N. line of said Owen N 71 W, 25,800 vrs from N.E. cor  
of same—at 135,870 vrs cross the S line of the Geo  
Foley survey N 71 W 95 vrs from the S.E. cor of same—  
At 171,600 vrs cross the S. line of the Justo Lindo, at  
17,915 vrs cross Brushy creek, run N 10 E—at 212,500 vrs  
the center of the S. L. N. R. R., N 73 1/2 W, 14,590 vrs from  
the station at Thorndale, Texas. At 237,250 vrs cross  
the N line of the Justo Lindo, N 19 E, 50,300 vrs from the  
S.W. cor of same, at 238,850 vrs cross Turkey creek. At  
261,550, cross the N line of the Adam Boat, 18,010 vrs  
S 71 W, from the N.E. cor. of same, and N 71 E, 3,600 vrs  
from the S.W. cor of the Amos Pollard. At 275,190 vrs  
cross the N line of said Pollard, and S. line of  
Amos Pollard No 1, N 71 E, 11,900 vrs from S.W. cor of same

at 28883, we cross the S line of J. W. Harvey survey,  
N 71° E, 119 vrs. from the S. W. cor. of same. At 30793 we  
cross the S. line of James Bradberry survey, N 71° E,  
119 vrs from S. W. cor. of same. At 32664 vrs. the S bank  
of San Gabriel River, run S. E. - At 32773 vrs. The  
N. bank of San Gabriel. At 33199 vrs, cross the E  
line of the Pedro Zarza, S 19 W, 280 vrs from the N. E.  
Cor. of same. At 33554 vrs cross the S. line of the  
Mc Davilla Eleven League, N 71 W, [115 vrs proper]  
217 vrs. from [Cor. claimed] S. E. cor. of same - At 38192  
vrs, the N. E. cor. of Williamson county Thence N 65 W,
