It is therefore ordered that H Livingston County surveyor of Braw Mills County be and he is hereby appointed, to proceed to ascertain survey and mark the line; 1st between Brawn and Mills County, beginning on the Colorado river at Western corner of said County on Monday the 28th day of November 1887 at 12 o'clock noon, and to cooperate with any person duly appointed by the proper authority of Brawn Co, and reporting to assist in said work. 2^d Between Mills and Comanche Counties beginning where the Mills County line crosses the old Brawn and Comanche County line at 12 o'clock noon, Dec 6th 1887.

3^d Between Mills and Hamilton Counties beginning where the Mills County line crosses the old Comanche County and Hamilton County line at 12 o'clock noon Dec 12th 1887 and, 4th, Between Mills and Sanjpasas Counties, beginning where ^{the} Mills County line crosses the old Hamilton and Sanjpasas County line, at 12 o'clock noon Dec 27th 1888, Co-operating in each

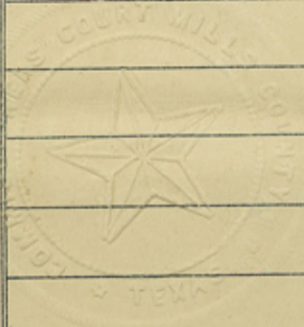
