were had:

To the Honorable Commissioners
Court of Mills County, Texas.

In obedience to an order
of your honorable body, passed at a special session
of the Court on the 8th day of January 1894 in con-
formity with instructions from the Commissioner of the
General Land Office, to have the line between Mills
and Brown Counties and the line between Mills
and Comanche Counties re-traced and ascertain
its position with reference to the different surveys
through which it passes. I herewith submit the
following Report:

I repaired to the S. E. corner of the Rich
and Blevis Survey on the 26th day of February, as
specified in your order, and as Brown County did not send
any one to represent her, I proceeded alone as follows:

Beginning at said S. E. cor of said Richard Blevis Sur. a
monad on the N. E. bank of Colorado river from which a huck-
berry mtd M. lrs S. 48 E. 1071 rs, a do mtd B. lrs N 86
W. 905 rs. Thence N 57° E. at 965 rs crossed the S. W. line
of the Watkins Nobles Sur. 385 rs, S 45 E. from its West cor-
ner and at 1900 rs 1st mile stone,

Thence N. 57° E. at 1782 vs crossed S. E. B. L. of said Nobles sur.
1143 vs S. 45 W. from its E. cor. and 1900 vs. 2^d mile stone,

Thence N. 57° E. at 1050 vs. crossed the N.E. B. L. of the
Heerlich's Trust sur. 243 vs. S. 45° E. from its N corner and
at 1900 vs the 3rd Mile Stone,

Thence N. 57° E. at 1093 vs. crossed the N.E. B. L. of the
Jno Mahewbager sur. 301 vs. N 45 W. from its East corner
and 1180 vs a branch 1900 vs the 4th Mile stone,

Mile Stone.

Thence N. 57° E. at 85 vs. crossed Buffalo creek
at 293 vs. crossed the N.W. B. L. of the J. R. Lanes sur. No
281 - 217 vs S. 45 W. from its N. cor. and at 515 vs.
crossed the N.E. B. L. of said sur. 45 vs. S. 45 E. from its
N. cor. and at 1435 vs. crossed the S.W. B. L. of the L. Ham-
mon sur. 436 vs. S. 45° E. from its W. cor. and at 1900
vs the 6th Mile Stone.

Thence N. 57° E. at 1002 vs crossed the S.W. B. L. of
the David Garner sur. 534 vs. S. 45 E. from its W. cor. and at
1900 vs the 7th Mile Stone.

Thence N. 57° E. at 583. crossed the S.W. B. L. of the
E. D. Pruitt sur. 827 vs. S. 45 E. from its W. cor. and at
1900 vs the 8th Mile Stone.

Thence N. 57° E. at 1900 vs. the ninth mile stone.

Thence N. 57° E. at 1900 vs the tenth mile stone.

Thence N. 57° E. at 1900 vs the eleventh mile stone.

Thence N. 57° E. at 1270 vs crossed the S. E. B. L.
of said E. D. Pruitt sur. 1344 vs. S. 45 W. from its lower
cor on Pecan Bayou and at 1540 vs crosses the S.W. B. L.
of the J. C. Vann pre. sur. 56 vs S. 45 E. from its West cor
1900 vs. the 12th mile stone

Thence N. 57° E. at 780 vs Pecan Bayou, 60 vs. wide and at
1900 vs the 13th mile stone on the Joseph M. Rhodes Survey -

Thence N 13° E. at 851 rs crossed the N. line of Fayette Copeland Surv. 782 rs. East of its N. W. cor. and at 1811 rs. crossed the S. line of the James Chambers Surv. 395- rs. N. of its S. E. cor and at 1900 rs the 18th mile stone.

E. cor. of said Ybarbo Surv. Thence N 82° E. at 1566 rs crossed the E. line of said F. Ybarbo Surv. 218 rs N. of its S. E. cor. and at 1900 rs. the 22nd mile stone.

Thence N 82° E. at 138 1/4 rs. crossed the E. line of Sec 42 and N. line of Sec 41, E. T. R. C. Co 424 rs. S. of the N. W. cor. of said Sec 41 and at 1900 rs the 25th mile stone.

Thence N 82° E. at 1659 rs. crossed the E. line of said Sec 41, 137 rs. S. of its N. E. cor. and at 1900 rs the 26th mile stone.
