To the Honorable Commissioners  
Court of Mills County, Texas.

In obedience to an order  
of your Honorable body, passed at a special session  
of the Court on the 8th day of January 1894 in con-  
formity with instructions from the Commissioner of the  
General Land Office, to have the line between Mills  
and Brown Counties and the line between Mills  
and Comanche Counties re-traced and ascertain  
its position with reference to the different surveys  
through which it passes, I herewith submit the  
following report:

I repaired to the S. E. Corner of the Rich  
and Blevins Survey on the 26th day of February, as  
specified in your order, and as Brown County did not send  
any one to represent her, I proceeded alone as follows:  
Beginning at said S. E. Cor of said Richard Blevins Smt. a  
Mound on the N. E. bank of Colorado river from which a hack  
berry marked M. brs S. 48 E. 107 1/2 vs. a do marked B. brs N 86  
W. 9 1/2 vs. thence N 57 E. at 965 vs crossed the S. W. line  
of the Watkins Nobles Smt. 385 vs. S 45 E. from its West cor.  
ner and at 1900 vs 1st Mile Stone,



Thence N. 57° E. at 1782 vs crossed S. E. B. L. of Said Nobles Sur. 1143 vs S 45 W. from its E. cor. and 1900 vs, 2<sup>d</sup> mile Stone,

Thence N 57° E. at 1050 vs. crossed the N. E. B. L. of the Heerliak Frost Sur. 243 vs. S. 45° E. from its N corner and at 1900 vs the 3rd Mile Stone,

Thence N. 57° E. at 1093 vs. crossed the N. E. B. L. of the Jno Mahrenberger Sur. 301 vs N 45, W. from its East corner and 1180 vs a branch 1900 vs the 4th mile stone,

Thence N. 57° E. at 165 vs. crossed the N. E. B. L. of the J. F. Quice pre. Sur. 99 vs. N 45 W. from its E. Cor. and at 1443 vs. crossed the N. E. B. L. of the Britton Dawson <sup>an S W Line of N B P Thomas</sup> Sur. 156 vs. N. 45 W. from its South Cor. and at 1900 vs. the 5th Mile Stone.

Thence N 57° E. at 85 vs. crossed Buffalo Creek at 293 vs. crossed the N. W. B. L. of the J. R. Lauss Sur. No 281. - 217 vs S. 45 W. from its N. cor. and at 515 vs. crossed the N. E. B. L. of Said Sur. 45 vs. S. 45 E. from its N. cor. and at 1435 vs. crossed the S. W. B. L. of the L. Damman Sur. 436 vs. S 45° E. from its N. cor. and at 1900 vs the 6th Mile Stone.

Thence N 57° E. at 1002 vs crossed the S. W. B. L. of the David Garner Sur. 534 vs. S 45 E. from its N. cor. and at 1900 vs the 7th Mile Stone.

Thence N. 57° E. at 583. crossed the S. W. B. L. of the E. D. Pruitt Sur. 827 vs. S. 45 E. from its N. cor. and at 1900 vs the 8th Mile Stone.

Thence N 57° E at 1900 vs. the ninth mile Stone.

Thence N 57° E. at 1900 vs the tenth mile Stone.

Thence N 57° E. at 1900 vs the eleventh mile Stone

Thence N 57° E at 1270 vs crossed the S. E. B. L. of said E. D. Pruitt Sur. 1344 vs. S 45 W. from its lower cor on Pecan Bayou and at 1540 vs crosses the S. W. B. L. of the J. C. Vann pre. Sur. 56 vs S 45 E. from its West cor 1900 vs the 12th mile Stone

Thence N 57° E. at 780 vs Pecan Bayou, 60 vs. wide and at 1900 vs the 13th mile Stone on the Joseph M. Rhodes Survey -



Thence  $N 57^{\circ} E$ , at 1580. vs. crossed S. E. P. L. of said  
Rhodes Surv. <sup>N.W. line of Surv No 2 S. F. I. N. Co</sup> 37 vs. S.  $45^{\circ} W$ . from its E. Cor. and at 1900 vs  
the 14<sup>th</sup> mile stone on the G.W. Thimney pr. Surv.

Thence  $N 57^{\circ} E$ , at 1015 vs. crossed the S. line of Surv  
No 2, S. F. I. N. 439 vs E of its S. W. cor. and at 1900 vs  
the 15<sup>th</sup> mile stone,

Thence  $N 57^{\circ} E$  at 1176 vs to the S. E. cor of Surv. No 1 S. F. I.  
N. a stone md, from which a L. O. bus N. 19 1/4 vs. Thence  
 $N 13^{\circ} E$ . at 724 vs. the 16<sup>th</sup> mile stone.

Thence  $N 13^{\circ} E$ . at 1900 vs the 17<sup>th</sup> mile stone

Thence  $N 13^{\circ} E$  at 851 vs crossed the N. line of  
Fayette Copeland Surv. 782 vs. East of its N. W. cor. and at  
1811 vs. crossed the S. line of the James Chambers Surv. 395  
vs. N. of its S. E. cor and at 1900 vs the 18<sup>th</sup> mile stone

Thence  $N 13^{\circ} E$ . at 1900 vs the 19<sup>th</sup> mile stone on the Penf.  
Head Surv.

Thence  $N 13^{\circ} E$ . at 1900 vs. the 20<sup>th</sup> mile stone.

Thence  $N 13^{\circ} E$  at 1900 vs the 21<sup>st</sup> mile stone

Thence  $N 13^{\circ} E$  at 134 vs the N. line of the Penf. Head  
Surv. and the S. line of the F. Ybarbo Surv. 762 vs. E. of the  
N. W. cor. of said Head, Surv. and 1550 vs N. of the S. E. cor of  
said Ybarbo Surv. Thence  $N 82^{\circ} E$  at 1566 vs crossed the E  
line of said F. Ybarbo Surv. 218 vs N of its S. E. Cor. and at  
1900 vs. the 22<sup>d</sup> mile stone.

Thence  $N 82^{\circ} E$ . at 1900 vs the 23<sup>d</sup> mile stone -
