Survey of part of the County line between the Counties of Austin
and Montgomery agreeable to an order of the Honorable John
P. Bonden Commiss' Genl. of the Land office. and having made the
necessary arrangements with the County Surveyor of the County of
Austin together with a Deputy of said County by the Name of
James C. Black. Beginning at the head of Spring Creek made a
Corner on a Black oak 20 inches dia. marked Δ from which a Black oak
20 in. dia. bears N 57° W marked Δ 10 varas dist and a Black oak 12 in. dia.
marked Δ bears S 79° W 22²/o varas dist. hence S 84° W
8046 varas to the head of Bond Creek on the North Bank a Black Oak
10 in. dia. marked Δ from which a post 14 in. dia. marked Δ bears S
26° 30' W 16 varas dist and a Black Oak 10 in. dia. marked Δ bears S 58° E 4²/o
varas dist.
