September 27<sup>th</sup> 1838

Survey of part of the County line between the Counties of Austin and Montgomery agreeable to an order of the Honorable John P Borden Commis- Genl. of the Land office. and having made the necessary arrangements with the County Surveyor of the County of Austin together with a Deputy of said County by the Name of James O. Black. Beginning at the head of Spring Creek made a corner on a Black oak 20 inches diam. marked  $\overline{\text{D}}$  from which a Black oak 20 in. dia. bears N 57° W. marked  $\overline{\text{C}}$  10 rods dist. and a Pine oak 12 in. dia. marked  $\overline{\text{E}}$  bears S 79° W. 22<sup>2</sup>/<sub>10</sub> rods dist. thence S 81° W

8046 rods to the head of Board Creek on the North Bank a Black oak 10 in. dia. marked  $\overline{\text{F}}$  from which a pos. can be in. dia. marked  $\overline{\text{G}}$  bears N 26° 30' W 16 rods. and a Black oak 10 in. dia. marked  $\overline{\text{H}}$  bears N 58° E 7<sup>2</sup>/<sub>10</sub> rods dist.
