September 27th 1838

Survey of part of the County line between the Counties of Austin
and Montgomery agreeable to an order of the Honorable John
p Borden Commis^r Genl. of the Land office, and having made the
necessary arrangements with the county Surveyor of the County of
Austin together with a Deputy of said County by the Name of
James C. Blair Beginning at the head of Spring Creek made a
corner on a black oak 20 inches diam. marked \bar{x} from which a Black oak
20 in. dia. bears N 57° W. marked \bar{y} 10 rods dist. and a pine cut 12 in. dia.
marked \bar{z} bears S 79° W. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods dist. thence S 56° W

8046 rods to the head of Bond Creek on the North Bank a black oak
10 in. dia. marked \bar{a} from which a pers. dia. be in. dia. marked \bar{b} bears
S 26° 30' W 16 rods and a black oak 10 in. dia. marked \bar{c} bears N 38° E 4 $\frac{1}{2}$
rods dist.
