Duly opened March 23rd 1855

A. Meeting of the Board of Commissioners appointed by the 14th Legislature of the State of Texas, to organize the County of Morris. Present J. A. Peacock, James R. Bridges ~~Wm~~ Skinner, J. Y. Bradfield, and David Smith. On Motion J. R. Bridges was elected Chairman and J. A. Peacock Secretary.

It is ordered by the Board of Commissioners that James C. Henderson be and is hereby employed to survey the lines of the County of Morris, for which service he is to receive the sum of Four Dollars, per day, and that said J. C. Henderson employ hands to carry the chain and work said lines, and that one of the Commissioners attend in making said Survey.

Be it remembered, that on this day it
being made to appear to the Satisfaction
of the Court that Western
Boundary of the County of Morris
is not sufficiently definite and
well defined, it is ordered by the
Court that W. S. Cannon County Surveyor
of said County is hereby appoin-
ted and instructed to ascertain
by actual survey the western
boundary of said County, and to
make and establish the lines and
names thereof in the manner pre-
scribed by an act of the Legislature
approved April 22 A.D. 1879. It is further
ordered by the Court that the said
W. S. Cannon be and he is hereby in-
structed and directed that he in
surveying and establishing said
Western Boundary line shall be
controlled and governed by the
boundaries of said County as stated
in the act of March 13rd A.D. 1875. The
purpose of said Survey being to
ascertain the point contemplated
as being "the nine mile post due east
of 'Up Pleasant'" as mentioned in said
act. It is further ordered that said
Cannon shall execute this order at
the earliest practicable moment and
that a copy of this order be forwarded



1 by the Clerk of this Court, to the County Court
2 of Titus County, and it is further ordered
3 that said Clerk shall give said Court
4 Notice of the time and place, when and
5 where said Survey shall be made
6 in accordance with section four
7 of said act, approved April 23^d
8 A.D. 1879.

Court in Session Sept. 16 1890

It is ordered by Court that the County Surveyor of this County, W.S. Cannon be and he is hereby directed that in the execution of the order passed by this Court Feby 15th A.D. 1890, that he shall ascertain the western boundary line of said County, as established by the commissioners appointed by an act of the Legislature of the State of Texas, passed on the 8th day of March 1875 entitled an act to create and provide for the organization of the County of Morris, and after he shall have ascertained said line, he is hereby ordered and directed to carefully resurvey said line so as the same will fully show the amount of land belonging to each County through which said line runs, and the said Cannon is directed to establish all necessary mile posts, land marks, &c.
