

Feb'y 13<sup>th</sup> 1890

Be it remembered that on this day it being made to appear to the satisfaction of the court that the Western boundary of the county of Morris is not sufficiently <sup>and</sup> well defined, It is ordered by the Court that W S Connor County Surveyor of said county is hereby appointed and instructed to ascertain by actual survey the Western boundary of said county and to make and establish the lines and corners thereof in the manner prescribed by an act of the Legislature approved April 22<sup>nd</sup> 1879. It is further ordered by the Court that the said W S Connor be and he is hereby instructed and directed that he in surveying and establishing said Western boundary line shall be controlled and governed by the boundaries of said county as stated in the act of March 13<sup>th</sup> 1878 the purpose of said survey being to ascertain the point contemplated as being the nine mile post due east of Mt Pleasant as mentioned in said act.

It is further ordered that the said Connor shall execute this order at the earliest practicable moment and that a copy of this order be forwarded by the Clerk of this Court to the County of Teton County. And it is further ordered that the said Clerk shall give said court notice of the time and place when and where said survey shall be made in accordance with section four of said act approved April 22<sup>nd</sup> 1889
