Dear Sir:

In reply to your letter of date July 14<sup>th</sup>, 1892, to Hon. H. H. Campbell, County Judge of this County, we have to say. Notice was given to the various counties as is proscribed by Art. 689, Sayles Civil Statutes. After the organization of Cottle County notice was given to that County. When the line between Cottle and Motley Counties was run, the Cottle County surveyor was present all the way through and approved of and adopted the work. When the line between Floyd and Motley Counties was run the surveyor employed by Floyd County, the County having been previously notified, was present and said he would adopt the work. The Counties interested are perfectly satisfied with the lines as run, and your fears of trouble and litigation in future are, in our opinion, unfounded. The work for Motley County was done by her duly qualified and bonded County Surveyor, under appointment by the Court, and it is suggested that a new bond was not necessary, nor was required by law. This surveyor was appointed County Surveyor by the Commissioners Court to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of J. P. Boyce, the former County Surveyor. Cottle and Floyd Counties desire that the lines thus run be adopted and applied by you. What is said above is taken with the view that our Surveyor will produce the N. B. line of Motley County from the S. W. Cor. of Hall County west
