Sir

I have run the following described line between the Counties of Jasper & Orange, Counties. I commenced the Line on the East bank of the Naches River opposite the middle of the mouth of Village Creek thence due East (Variation 9°15' E) 1600 was through low Swamps to Hammock Land at 3000 was Pine woods (Sarah Grays South line is 188 was south of this line & Patsey Lenneys South line is 220 was North of this line) at 3640 was the Beaumont & Jasper Road, at 5600 was a Branch of Ten mile Creek at 6980 was Nixes Ferry Road. at 7230 was Ten mile Creek 10 vs wide, at 9410 was a Creek 3 vs wide running into 10 mile Creek at this point (no line marked to this place) I chained from Sarah Grays line & find it 140 was south of this line & Patsey Lenney south line 300 was North of this line, At 12100 was I connect again with Patsey Lenneys SE Corner & find it 325 was North of my line. At a point due South of P^t Lenny SE Corner & 425 was South of the same I find an Old Blazed line running East it begining at this place this I follow at 12400 was I find a Corner with Pine bearing trees m^kd X this corner is 28 was south of this old blazed line, at 16630 was I find a Red Oak 17 inch diam m^kd X on the North side & a White Oak nearly West but not marked the distances correspond nearly with Ryans NE Corner, but I could find no line running North or South at 19885 was this distance is 1040 was North of John Coles (or Shipp's Labor) N.W. Corner at 20670 a Road at 21630 was a small branch 3 vs wide

At 21800 was a Branch running into Cow Bayou & at this is at the West edge of Cow Bayou marsh a large marsh impassable for Horses & nearly so for man, at the distance of 23250 was to the West bank of Cow Bayou, this is nearly the upper edge of the Cow Bayou timber all of the timber on this side is young & I could find the Collier North line or the County line at this point As soon as the water falls I will go down from the Newton side & remark the line to the Sabine & notify you of its length, you may be able by some connections in your Office & this letter to get the length of the Jasper County line
