In the matter of
establishing a line between Pecos and
Pecos Counties, from the mouth of Delo-
man Creek, where it empties into the Pecos
River, to the mouth of San Francisco River
where it empties into the Rio Grande.
This matter came on to be heard and was
submitted upon the records of surveys
and the laws in regard to boundary
lines between said counties, and during
the proofs submitted and it appear-
ing to the satisfaction of the court that
the line between this County and Pe-
sidos County from the mouth of Delo-
man Creek to the mouth of San Fran-
cisco River, where it empties into
the Rio Grande are not sufficiently
definite and well defined it is therefore
ordered adjudged & decreed - that Wm
C. Nelson County Surveyor of Pecos
County be and he is hereby appointed
to ascertain by actual survey the bound-
ary line between said Pecos & Pecos

Comities from the mouth of Delaware
Creek where it empties into the Pecos River
to the mouth of San Francisco River where
it empties into the Rio Grande. To be com-
menced at the mouth of Delaware Creek
where it empties into the Pecos River.
It is further ordered adjudged and de-
creed that the said Thomas C. Nelson
shall make an initial point at
said mouth of Delaware Creek where
it empties into the Pecos River and es-
tablish and make at said initial
point one certain mound of stone, not
less than two feet high and then pro-
ceed to run on said boundary line
in a southerly direction as described
in an act to organize the County of
Pecos. Approved May 3rd 1871. a dis-
tance of one mile, and then and there
place a monument of stone not
less than two feet high, Thence contin-
ue on said boundary line, as de-
signated by said act to the mouth
of San Francisco River where it
empties into the Rio Grande placing
a stone monument at the end of
each and every mile. Not less than
two feet high thence said initial ~~point~~ ^{corner}

And at said initial corner to place a
summit not less than two feet high
and describe them that the same is
an initial corner, And it is further
ordered, adjudged and decreed that said
survey in his field notes of said sur-
vey shall give an accurate descrip-
tion of all prominent natural points
objects corner by a adjacent to
said line as well as of the corner and
line of survey on or near said bound-
ary, And it is further ordered ad-
judged and decreed that a certified
copy of this order be sent by the clerk
of this court to the County Clerk of said
Principis County and in further
pursuance of this order it is
ordered that said Thomas C. Nelson
proceed to run said line as herein
before directed and that on the 2nd
day of August 1879, he proceed
to Barco Springs for the purpose
of having them and there a
meeting with the surveyor appoin-
ted by said Principis County, should one
be appointed & on the 8th day of Au-
gust 1879 he shall commence
surveying running at said initial cor-

men to wit: The mouth of Delaware
Creek when it empties into the
Pecos River as aforesaid and con-
tinue from day to day and that un-
less a survey is appointed ac-
cording to law by said ^{Proviso} ~~Surveyor~~
County, said lines shall never-
theless proceed to run and establish
said boundary lines as herein di-
rected, the same as if the survey
for Proviso were present.

And it is further ordered adjudg-
ed and decreed that said Sur-
veyor take the oath and file the
bond required by law and when
said lines shall have been sur-
veyed and marked as herein di-
rected that said Surveyor shall
make due return of the field
notes and map to this Court,
for its further ^{active} on the premises
