The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above bounden Thomas C. Nelson was appointed by the County Court through an order made at its July Term 1879, to run the boundary lines between Pecos and Pecos Counties, Now should the aforesaid Thomas C. Nelson well and truly Comply with the terms of said order of the County Court aforesaid, and in conformity with the Law regulating the running of Boundary Lines between Counties and especially with an act entitled "An Act establishing and prescribing the manner of ascertaining the boundaries of Counties" Approved April

2 before set forth shall be null and void,
