Field notes of the  
division line between the Counties of  
Polk and Trinity

Beginning at a living  
Mulberry tree on the East bank of the  
Trinity River at a point bearing from  
the Mouth of Kiesapoo Creek, about  
N. 56° W 10,000 Vrs dist and S. 39° E  
730 Vrs from where the division line  
between the two. A. W. de Sajaerza Sequa  
touches the East. bank of the said  
Trinity River - Said Mulberry  
tree is marked on its Eastern side  
thus  $\overset{P}{X}$  and on its Western side  $\overset{T}{X}$  from  
which a 14 Ash marked  $\overset{P}{X}$  brs S. 64° E  
12 vrs and a 30 inch Cottonwood marked  
 $\overset{T}{X}$  brs N. 31° E. 2 1/4 vrs and an 8 inch  
Sycamore marked Polk brs, S. 40° W  
4 1/2 vrs. Thence N. 49° E at 4,100 vrs  
Cross Brushy Creek at 17,000 Vrs Cross  
Kiesapoo Creek, at 33,450 vrs, cross  
the Trinity & Sabine R.R. 320 vrs E,  
of its 28 mile Post and at 40,045  
vrs the Mouth of Bull Creek at which  
point a Iron Mulberry Post 8. inches  
Square was set in the ground marked  
on the East side  $\overset{P}{X}$  and on the west  
 $\overset{T}{X}$  from which a sweet Gum standing  
on the East bank marked  $\overset{P}{X}$  and a

Birch Marked  $\text{F}$  Thence  $\text{N. } 40^{\circ} 30'$   
E, at 2700 Yrs cross Augusts Creek  
at 17,190 Yrs the Mouth of Alabama  
Creek; at which point a pitch pine  
post Six feet long was set in the  
ground three feet. Marked,  $\text{P. F.}$

Thus completing said line—

This line is marked with  
four marks on the trees, and at the end  
of every mile an each on rock mound  
was erected, two feet high, and trees  
marked to correspond, with the number  
of the mile.

This line crosses the lines of  
the surveys named below as follows, to wit:  
The N. boundary line of the Paddy Ryan  
600 Yrs S.  $75^{\circ} 24'$  of its N.E. Corner, the E.  
line of the M. Purvis, 320 acres, 335 Yrs  
N. of its S.E. Corner, the W. line of J. B.  
Gaines 547. Yrs. S. of its N.W. Corner, the S  
line of the M. Charles Brimingham 134  
Yrs E. of its S.W. Corner, The W. line of the  
Houston County School land 790. Yrs S. of  
its N.W. Corner, the S line of the J. Jones  
357 Yrs. East of its S.W. Corner, and the  
N. line of the Geo Bondies, 300 Yrs N. of  
its N.E. Corner The Mouth of Bull  
Creek is situated 1430 Yrs N. and 510  
W. of the S.E. Corner of the Juan Falcon  
Carronera League survey. The line  
from this point to the Mouth of

Alabama Creek crosses the N. line of  
the R. Pierce League 1934 200 E. of its  
N.W. Corner - The E. line of the Jesse  
James 312 200 N. of its S.E. Corner,  
The (reputed) N. line of the J. M. Dean  
League 1550 200 N. of its N.E. Corner  
the N. line of the J. A. Lee 664 200 N.  
of his most Southern S.W. Corner, and  
the N. line of the same 265 200 N. of James  
Hoods N.W. Corner, Continuing same  
Course N. 40° 30' E. 740 200 to the mouth  
of Alabama Creek.


