Field notes of the  
division line between the Counties of  
Denton and Trinity

Beginning at a living  
Mulberry tree on the East bank of the  
Trinity River at a point bearing from  
the Mouth of Kiestapoo Creek, about  
N.  $56^{\circ} W$  10.000 Vrs dist and S.  $39^{\circ} E$   
730 Vrs from where the division line  
between the two A. M. de Lajara League  
touches the East. bank of the Said  
Trinity River - Said Mulberry  
tree is marked on its Eastern side  
thus  $X^P$  and on its Western side  $X^T$  from  
which a 14 Ash Marked  $X^P$  brs S.  $64^{\circ} E$   
12 vrs and a 30 inch Cottonwood Marked  
 $X^T$  brs N.  $31^{\circ} E$ ,  $21\frac{1}{4}$  vrs and an 8 inch  
Sycamore Marked Poll brs S.  $4^{\circ} W$   
 $4\frac{1}{2}$  vrs. Thence N.  $49^{\circ} E$  at 4100 Vrs  
cross Brushy Creek at 17,000 Vrs cross  
Kiestapoo Creek at 33,400 vrs. cross  
the Trinity & Sabine R. R. 320 vrs E.  
of its 28 mile Post and at 4046  
vrs the mouth of Bull Creek which at  
point a live Mulberry Post 8. inches  
Square was set in the ground marked  
on the East side  $X^P$  and on the west  
 $X^T$  from which a Sweet Gum Standing  
on the East bank Marked  $X^P$  and a

Birch Marked X. Thence N. 40° 30'  
E. at 2700 Yrs cross Augusta creek  
at 17.190 Yrs the Mouth of Alabama  
Creek; at which point a pitch pine  
post six feet long was set in the  
ground three feet. Marked P. X.  
Thus completing said line-

This line is marked with  
four hacks on the trees and at the end  
of every mile an each on road ground  
was erected, two feet high, and trees  
marked to correspond with the number  
of the mile.

This line crosses the lines of  
the surveys named below as follows, to wit,  
the N. boundary line of the Polly Ryan  
600 yrs S. 75° W. of its N. E. corner, the E.  
line of the N. Paroys, 320 acres, 335 yrs  
N. of its S. E. corner, the W. line of J. B.  
Gaines 547. yrs. S. of its N. W. corner, the S.  
line of the St. Charles Birmingham 134  
yrs E. of its S. W. corner, the N. line of the  
Houston County School land 790. yrs S. of  
its N. W. corner, the S. line of the J. Jones  
357 yrs. East of its S. W. corner, and the  
N. line of the G. G. Bondies, 300 yrs N. of  
its N. E. corner. The mouth of Bull  
Creek is situated 1430 yrs N. and 510  
ft. of the S. E. corner of the just mentioned  
Carrollton League Survey. The line  
from this point to the mouth of

Alabama Creek crosses the N. line of  
the R. Bierroa League 1934 Vrs E. of its  
N. W. Corner - The E line of the Jessie  
League 312 Vrs N. of its S E. corner,  
the (reputed) N. line of the J. H. Dean  
League 1550 Vrs W. of its N. E. corner  
the E line of the J. A. Lee 664 vrs N.  
of his most Southern SW corner, and  
the N. line of the same 265 Vrs N. of James  
Woods N. W. corner, continuing same  
Course N. 40° 30' E. 740 vrs to the mouth  
of Alabama Creek.
