It appearing to the County Court  
of Potter County Texas; That the boundary  
lines of Potter County Texas are not suf-  
ficiently well defined, established and  
designated.

It is therefore ordered by the  
Court on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of May 1897. at the  
regular term of said Court in accor-  
dance with Articles 799 To 808 inclu-  
sive of the Revised Statutes of 1895 of the  
State of Texas, that the following bound-  
ary lines of Potter County be established  
surveyed, defined and designated accor-  
ding to Law.

The North, South, East and West  
lines of said County, and that the North  
East, North West, South West and South  
East corners of said County be established  
and marked, accordance with and

conform to the Revised Statutes of 1895  
And the mounds and monuments  
shall be placed, marked and designated  
according to Law.

The Court hereby appoints W. D.  
Twichell an experienced Surveyor to make  
said surveys and to do said work, who  
shall receive Three dollars per miles  
run and lines lawfully surveyed and  
designated between the Counties of  
Potter + Moore and Potter and Randall  
and Potter and Oldham and Potter and  
Carson Counties.

✓ Said surveyor will begin on the 20<sup>th</sup>  
day of August 1897 to survey establish  
and designate the boundary lines between  
Potter and Carson Counties. In order  
to be more certain and accurate in ma-  
king said surveys and locating said  
N.E. corner of Potter County. Said survey-  
or will on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D.  
1897. Begin a survey at the N. E. corner  
of Lipscomb County Texas. Thence West  
90 Miles to the N. E. corner of Sherman  
County Texas. Thence South 60 miles  
to the N. E. corner of Potter County

✓ The said W. D. Twichell Surveyor  
will on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August 1897  
begin and survey and designate the  
North boundary line of Potter County  
between Potter and Moore County.  
Beginning at the N. E. corner of Potter  
County. Thence West thirty miles  
to the N. W. corner of Potter County.

The said W. D. Twichell surveyor

✓ Will on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August 1897 begin and survey and designate the West boundary line of Potter County between Potter & Oldham County Beginning at the N.W. corner of Potter County and thence South thirty miles to the South West corner of Potter County.

✓ The said W. D. Twichell will on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of May 1897 begin and survey and designate the South boundary line of Potter County Texas. between Potter and Randall County's Beginning at the S.W. Corner of Potter County, Thence East thirty miles to the S. E. corner of Potter County.

✓ The said W. D. Twichell Surveyor will on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1897. begin and survey and designate the East boundary line of Potter County, Texas. Between Potter & Carson Counties Texas. Beginning at the North East corner of Potter County, and thence - South thirty miles to the South East corner of Potter County.

The said sum of \$3<sup>00</sup> per mile will be due and payable to the said W. D. Twichell when the said boundary lines of Potter County have been surveyed and designated with the proper mounds and monuments and all things complied with according to Law. And the boundary lines, mounds and monuments marked designated and placed by the said W. D. Twichell.

Have been Approved by the Commissioner of the General Land Office at Austin Texas.

The agreement about the \$3<sup>00</sup> per mile here specified to be paid has reference to the four boundary lines of Potter County only and not to the Survey from Lipscomb County to the N. E. corner of Potter County Texas.

A true notice of this order certified to by the County Clerk of Potter County Texas shall be made and delivered to the County Judge of Potter County Texas to be served upon each of the foregoing County Judges here to set out in this order.
