Your instructions for me to begin at the N.E. corner of the Penhandle - or Lipscomb Co. meets with my hearty approval. Potter County and Randall County together guarantee me \$3000 for the work, not feeling able to pay the full price. As the country is dry and part of it sandy I am afraid this amount will not justify me in undertaking the same grade of line work as I used on the State line from the S.E. corner of New Mexico to the N.W. corner of Bailey County, Tx. for that work requires that I should camp on the line every night, in order to secure four check observations on Polaris. I was paid \$3,33 $\frac{1}{3}$ per mile for the State line
