The field notes of Potter East line sent you yesterday calls for N.E. Moore to bear 476 south from corner on the ground. This is changed from 476 to 747 or south to properly apportion the excess and is so returned to all the Counties. I have asked Randall to correct minutes to conform. Likewise the corner of Potter is corrected from 406 south to 542 south. This gives Sherman 30 miles + 1629 feet + 271 or excess, and Moore County 30 miles + 271 or excess and Potter County 30 miles + 271 or excess.
