That the line of lines to be run, and the corners to be established, and marked, are described in substance as follows:

RANDALL: To re-establish south line of Potter and north line of Randall Counties.

OLDHAM : Establish line between Potter and Oldham Counties, establishing the northwest corner of Potter and the southwest corner of Potter.

MOORE : Establish line between Potter and Moore Counties, including northeast and northwest corners of Potter County Texas.

Meeting Places: (1) On the southeast corner of Potter County, to re-establish line between Potter and Randall Counties: (2) On the northeast corner of Potter County to Establish Line between Moore and Potter Counties: (3) Northwest corner of Potter County to establish line between Potter and Oldham Counties.

Herein Fail Not, but proceed in accordance with the order of this Court and perform the duties herein prescribed, in accordance with Article 1582 of the Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas.

McBride and W.J.Williams, by virtue of order of the <u>County</u> <u>County</u> ioners' Court of Potter County and notice to the <u>County</u> Court of Randall County, setting <u>Rebruary 23, 1931</u>, as the date to begin the survey, to which the <u>County</u> Court responded by appointing W.J.Williams to represent Randall County by order made <u>August 13, 1930</u>

The surveyors met at the time and place designated and proceeded to retrace and re-mark the line between Potter and Randall Counties, conforming with the line marked by W.D.Twichell, special surveyor for Potter and Randall Counties, made in the year 1898.

The positions and areas of sections in Block 2, A. B. & M. are considered to be where now held, indicated by fences and centers of public roads as these locations will likely remain as they are now held by virtue of limitation, acquiescence, agreement or other reasons which will constitute estoppel.

The positions and areas of sections in Blo:k 9, B. S. & F. conform with resurvey of Block 9, made by state surveyor, W.D.Twichell. Section No. 4, Block 5 Z and sections 32, 33 and 34, Block 8, crossed by the west end of the line between the counties are considered to be where now held and defined by fences and centers of public roads and areas are so computed.
