

Field Notes of a Survey of the County line between Brewster and Presidio Counties, Texas, as made by J. R. Marmion County Surveyor of Presidio County, duly appointed for that purpose by the Commissioners Court of Presidio County. And Surveyed November 13th 1889 and December 7th 1889.

Beginning at a Stone Mound, the N.W. corner of Brewster County, being the S.E. corner of Survey No 36, Sect. No 3376. G.C. & S.F. Ry Co. The Cap rock of which is Marked ^{N.E.} P.C. and which Mound is in the bottom of a deep Guelch, —

No 1

Hence South, At 1400 vs Cross a creek trending S.E. at one mile built a stone Mound Cap rock Marked C.L. 1.M.

No 2

Hence South, At 800 vs Cross Arollo, One Mile to rock Mound, cap rock Marked C.L. 2.M.

No 3

Hence South, at 600 vs Summit of Mountain One Mile built a Stone Mound at foot of Mountain, Cap rock Marked C.L. 3.M.

No 4

Hence South, at 25 vs Cross a Creek at one mile put in a cedar post 3 feet in the ground Marked C.L. 4.M.

No 5

Hence South, at one mile built a Stone Mound at base of a rocky cliff, Marked C.L. 5.M.

No 6

Hence South, at 1784 vs Cross R.R. at Station N° 11.425+04

at one Mile, put a cedar post in the ground 3 feet, being
116 varas South of R.R. crossing Marked C.L. 6.M.

Thence South, over rough hills, at One Mile put in cedar
post Marked C.L. 7.M.

Nº 8

Thence South. At one Mile put up a stone Mound, Cap
rock Marked C.L. 8.M.

Nº 9

Thence South at 250 varas Cross R.R. at 450 vs cross it again
1075 vs Summit of hill at 1574 vs cross R.R.
One Mile put up a rock Mound Marked C.L. 9.M.

Nº 10

Thence South, at $145\frac{1}{2}$ Varas Cross R.R. for the fifth time
One Mile, put up a Stone Mound Marked
C.L. 10.M.

Nº 11

Thence South, at one Mile put up a rock Mound
Marked C.L. 11.M.

Nº 12

Thence South, One Mile put up a rock Mound Marked
C.L. 12.M.

Nº 13

Thence South, at one Mile put up a cedar post 3 feet
in the ground Marked C.L. 13.M.

Nº 14

Thence South, over prairie, at one Mile a cedar post 3 feet
in the ground Marked C.L. 14.M.

Nº 15

Thence South, over prairie at one Mile put cedar post
3 feet in the ground Marked C.L. 15.M.

Thence South, at one Mile put in a cedar post in a flat
Marked c. 16.M.

N°17

Thence South, One Mile put in Cedar post Marked c. 17.M.

N°18

Thence South over prairie one Mile a cedar post Marked
c. 18.M.

N°19

Thence South, One Mile a cedar post Marked c. 19.M.

N°20

Thence South, at one Mile a cedar post Marked c. 20.M.

N°21

Thence South, One Mile put in Cedar post Marked c. 21.M.

N°22

Thence South, at one Mile put in Cedar post 3 feet in the
ground Marked c. 22.M.

N°23

Thence South, over a prairie One Mile on Earth Mound
2½ feet high with 4 reference pits and a
Cap rock Marked c. 23.M.

N°24

Thence South, at one Mile on Earth Mound 2½ feet high
with 4 reference pits and a Cap rock Marked c. 24.M.

N°25

Thence South, At 1000 Varas, a point from which the S.E.
corner of Survey N° 494 Block N° 8 G, H, & S. A.
Ry Co. bears S. 40° 25' East 262 Varas at one Mile
a large Earth Mound 3 feet high with 4 ref-
erence pits & cap rock Marked c. 25.M.

Thence South, at one mile an earth Mound (500 vs North from base of a high hill) with a Cap rock Marked c. 26, M.

Nº 27

Thence South, One Mile, a Stone Mound Marked c. 27, M.

Nº 28

Thence South, at 920 vs top of Mesa, One Mile put up a Stone Mound, Cap rock Marked c. 28, M.

Nº 29

Thence South, At 1550 vs, a rock Mound 6 feet high on brim of Rim Rock. Marked "Cofine" One mile a Stone Mound half way down South Slope of Mesa Cap rock Marked c. 29, M.

Nº 30

Thence South, over a very rough Country, at one mile a Stone Mound, Cap rock Marked c. 30, M.

Nº 31

Thence South, among foot hills, at one mile a Stone Mound in a Creek Valley, Marked c. 31, M.

Nº 32

Thence South, One mile a Stone Mound, on North side of a boulder point and 8 vs from its Summit Cap rock Marked c. 32, M.

Nº 33

Thence South, over a rough Mesa, One mile a rock Mound Cap rock Marked c. 33, M.

Nº 34

Thence South, one mile (in Green Valley) a Stone mound Cap rock Marked c. 34, M.

Thence South, At 1830 yrs. Road to Peña Colorado, One mile
a Stone Mound, Marked c. 35, M.

Thence South, one mile to a Stone Mound, Marked c. 36, M.

Thence South, one mile, a Stone Mound Marked c. 37, M.

Thence South, one mile, a Stone Mound, Marked c. 38, M.

Mesa Mountain, Marked c. 39, M.

Thence South, at one Mile, a Stone Mound on North side
of a hill, and Marked c. 40, M.

Thence South, one Mile, a Stone Mound, Marked c. 41, M.

Thence South, one Mile, a Stone Mound, Marked c. 42, M.

Thence South, one Mile, a Stone Mound, Marked c. 43, M.

Thence South, one Mile, a Stone Mound Marked c. 47, M.

Whence South, One Mile, a Stone Mound, Marked C.L. 48, M.

Note. From this Mound Chas Walker's Well bears
N.35°34' East 300 vs.

Whence South, at one Mile, a Stone Mound on top of Mesa
Marked C.L. 49, M.

Nº 50

Whence South, one mile a Stone Mound Marked C.L. 50, M.

Nº 51

Whence South, one Mile to a Stone Mound Marked C.L. 51, M.

Nº 52

Whence South, one Mile, a Stone Mound in a brushy
flat. The Cap rock C.L. 52, M.

Nº 53.

Whence South, At 250 vs a Wire fence, trending E.N.E.
One Mile a Stone Mound on the North Side
of a Mesa hill, Cap rock Marked C.L. 53, M.

Nº 54

Whence South, At 820 vs Summit of Mesa, One Mile a
Stone Mound on Mesa and Marked C.L. 54, M.

Nº 55

Whence South, At one Mile a Stone Mound in a deep
Arollo, and Marked C.L. 55, M.

Nº 56

Whence South, At One Mile a Stone Mound on Mesa &
320 vs North of its South Rim Rock, and Marked
C.L. 56, M.

Nº 57

Whence South, at 500 varas cross a creek trending
S.S.W. One mile to a Stone Mound Marked
C.L. 57, M.

Nº 58

Thence South, At 600 vs Cross the Bandera Creek
The Bandera Park being 500 vs West of
line, one Mile, a Stone Mound Marked c. 58, M.

Nº 59

Thence South at 700 vs Cross the Alamo de Cesario Creek
One Mile to a rock Mound Marked c. 59, M.

Nº 60

Thence South, one Mile, to a Stone Mound in a Cañon
on North Side of Mountain, and Marked c. 60, M.

Nº 61

Thence South, one Mile, to a Stone Mound on South Slope
of Mt, and Marked c. 61, M.

Nº 62

Thence South, at 1200 vs a point on top of hill. One Mile
to a Stone Mound in a Swag between the
hills, and Marked c. 62, M.

Nº 63

Thence South, One Mile to a Stone Mound on the North
Side of a deep Gulch, ground very rough
and Cap rock of Mound is Marked c. 63, M.

Nº 64

Thence South, One Mile a Stone Mound. Cap rock Marked
c. 64, M.

Nº 65

Thence South, one Mile, over Many Small hills, to Stone
Mound, Marked c. 65, M.

Nº 66

Thence South. One mile over sloping hills to a stone mound on North side of a hill, with a small hill West, and a large Mountain East. cap rock marked c.e. 66.M.

Nº 67

Thence South, one mile, a stone mound marked c.e. 67.M.

Nº 68

Thence South, over a rough hilly country, one mile to a stone mound, marked c.e. 68.M.

Nº 69

Thence South, one mile to a stone mound on the North side of a rocky boulder point of a hill, & cap rock marked c.e. 69.M.

Nº 70

Thence South, one mile, a stone mound marked c.e. 70.M.

Note. This mound is near the summit of the last range of hills, going down to the Rio Grande,

Nº 71

Thence South, one mile to a rock mound in a Ravine and marked c.e. 71.M.

Nº 72

Thence South, one mile, to a rock mound marked 72.M.

Nº 73

Thence South, one mile, over a rough hilly country, to a stone mound marked c.e. 73.M.

Nº 74

Thence South, one mile to a stone mound in a gulch and marked c.e. 74.M.

Nº 75

Thence South. At 1700 vs a large Monument 6 feet high
Near Summit of Mountain, Marked "C Line"
one mile a Stone Mound Marked c. 75.M.

Nº 76

Thence South, one mile to Stone Mound on top of Mesa
Marked c. 76.M.

Nº 77

Thence South, one mile, a Stone Mound Marked c. 77.M.
on the Mile on Rim Rock of large Mountain
a Stone Monument 6 feet high with flag in
Centre, and Cap rock Marked "C Line"

Nº 78

Thence South, one mile, a Stone Mound, Marked c. 78.M.

Nº 79

Thence South, at 1344 Varas, put up a Stone Mound
and Marked it 600.V. N. of S.E.C. This
being as near to the Rio Grande as it
was possible to get. Making in all 79
Miles and 44 varas, Total length of this
East line of County.
