Dear Sir,

Below I give you the field notes of Rains County, to wit
Beginning at a stake in the Sabine
river, about 500 ~~ors~~ 860' East from the S. E.
Corner of a Survey in the name of J.
A. S. Erwin. Thence North about six Degrees
West, at about ~~in~~ miles passing through
the S. E. Corner of a Survey in the of
O. P. Bell (this is the Jim Bridges Survey)
at 17 miles a stake in the McMillian
boundary line between Wood &
Hoptins Counties, about 400 ~~ors~~ East
of the East line of a Survey in the
name of Green Lane & said corner
being in a Survey in the name
of Thomas Lee.

Thence west in said McMillian
line $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles the original N. W.
Corner of Wood County, and S. W.
Hoptins County, at $15\frac{1}{4}$ miles a
stake in W. P. Bhasan's Survey in
Hunt County, about 5700 ~~ors~~ 1619' N
from the S. E. Corner of same.

Thence South $17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West about $5\frac{3}{4}$
miles to a stake on the N. bank of said
Sabine river about 400 ~~ors~~ 811' N
from the N. E. Corner of a Survey
in the name of J. L. Winston
Thence down said river, with its

Meanders to the Beginning.
