



1 At a regular Term of the County Court held
2 in Randall County, February 21st 1901, the
3 following order was passed.

4 It appearing to the Court that the east Bou-
5 ndary line of Randall County Texas, is not
6 sufficiently defined and well defined. Therefo-
7 re be it ordered by the Court that Jas L. Grey
8 make an actual survey between Randall and
9 Armstrong Counties for the purpose of estab-
10 lishing the said East Boundary line of
11 Randall County, and that said Surveyor
12 put up good and substantial Corners at
13 the north East and South East corners of said
14 Randall County and also put up good Stone
15 or gas pipe each mile run on said East
16 Boundary line of said County and do any
17 and other things necessary for establishing
18 said boundary line between Randall and
19 Armstrong Counties, that said work begin
20 at the north East corner of Randall County
21 on or about the 1st day of Mar 1901.

22 And it is further ordered the Clerk of this
23 Court send a copy of this order to the County
24 Court of Armstrong County Texas. It is further
25 ordered by the Court that said Surveyor be
26 allowed three dollars per mile for each lineal
27 mile run on said East Boundary line of
28 said County or the sum of \$90.⁰⁰ for run-
29 ning and marking out definitely the 30
30 Statute miles as set fourth in field notes
31 of said Randall County (the County to
32 pay for material or mile Posts) to be



1 paid when said work is done and
2 approved by the Comr of the General Land
