

At a Term of the County Commissioners Court held in and for Refugio County, Texas, at the Court house thereof in the Town of Refugio, Beginning on the 10th day of August, and ending on the 11th day of August, A. D. 1891.

Hon. James O. Saffrey, Judge, Presiding, When the following orders were passed. To-wit: - - -

It is ordered by the Court that the report of Mess. M. D. O'Sullivan and H. L. Tally surveyors of the County line between Refugio and Isoliad Counties be in all things approved, and the Clerk of this Court is hereby ordered to enter the same on the minutes of this Court, and send a certified copy of said report and map to the General Land Office at Austin, Texas.

Which said Report is as follows.

To-wit: - To the Honorable County Commissioners Court of Refugio County, Texas.

In accordance with the order of your Hon. Court, and the order of the Hon. County Commissioners Court of Isoliad County.

We, M. D. O'Sullivan surveyor, appointed on the part of Refugio County and Hugh L. Tally, surveyor, appointed on the part of Isoliad County, Met on the 7th day of July 1891, at the rock pillar, the same being the East Corner of the G. Barrera Grant of land on San Antonio River, and proceeded to survey the Boundary line between Isoliad and Refugio Counties, as follows:

13300 vrs. Rock No. 7, at 14111 vrs. intersect
N. Line of C. E. P. D. Ed. M. Co. Scrip No. 40, File
254, from which a rock the N. E. corner of
said survey bis. S. 81° E. 608 vrs. at 15200
vrs. Rock No. 8, at 17100 vrs. Rock No. 9,
at 17391 vrs. to D. M. O'Connor's pasture
fence, at 19000 vrs. Rock No. 10, at 19815 vrs.
intersect North Boundary line of C. E. P. D.
Ed. M. Co. Scrip No. 76. File — and 579 vrs.
S. 81° E. from S. W. Cor. of same, at 20900 vrs.
Rock No. 11, at 21740 vrs. put a stake in
County line, the upper back corner of P. Shelly
survey bis. S. 68¾ W. 64 vrs. at 22800 vrs.
Rock No. 12, at 22865 vrs. P. Shelly upper
line, whence a rock Mix'd R. W. on the lower
back corner of P. Shelly survey bis. S. 81½ W. 868

vrs. and a rock the N. E. corner of John Shelly
 survey bears N. 81½ E. 55-7 vrs. at 24.400 vrs.
 cross Refugio and Galind Road, at 24.700 vrs.
 Rock No. 13, at 26.600 vrs. Rock No. 14. at 27.200
 vrs. intersect J. Shelly lower line and Cross
 Dog Branch, at 28.500 vrs. Rock No. 15. at
 29.203 vrs. lower line of Mc Mill and upper
 line of Coughlin surveys, which point is
 N. 81½ E. 5.600 vrs. from a rock to the lower
 corner of said Mc Mill and Redmond survey
 on Blanco Creek, at 30.096 vrs. Spring Creek,
 at 30.400 vrs. Rock No. 16. at 32.300 vrs.
 Rock No. 17. at 32.455 vrs. a Live Oak
 about 30 inches in diameter with 2 prongs
 one marked R. and the other S. also
 with 4 marks for an angle. this being the
 Corner of County on Blanco Creek.
