On the third day of February, 1982, came on to be heard the above styled and numbered cause, and came the Plaintiff, Refugio County, by and through its attorneys of record and announced ready for trial, and came the Defendant, Calhoun County, by and through its attorneys of record and announced ready for trial, and no jury having been demanded, all matters of fact and things in controversy were submitted to the court.

The court, after considering the pleadings and the stipulations of the parties, and after hearing the evidence and arguments of counsel, finds and is of the opinion that the true and correct location of that part of the boundary between Refugio County and Calhoun County, beginning at the mouth of the Guadalupe River and ending at the southeast corner of the J. C. Solberg Survey, is as follows:

Beginning at the mouth of the Guadalupe River; thence with the shorelines of Guadalupe Bay and San Antonio Bay to Grassy Point on the northern and eastern headland of Hynes Bay, at latitude 28°24'00" north and longitude 96°46'40" west; thence in a straight line to McDowell Point on the southern and western headland of Hynes Bay, at latitude 28°21'51" north and longitude 96°47'41" west; thence with the shoreline of San Antonio Bay to the southeast corner of the J. C. Solberg Survey.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the portion of the boundary between Refugio County and Calhoun County beginning at the mouth of the Guadalupe River and ending at the southeast corner of J. C. Solberg Survey be, and the same is hereby, determined and established to be the boundary described hereinabove.

We represented Refugio County in the above cause and on its behalf enclose for your information a certified copy of the Final Judgment dated April 27, 1982. The Judgment has the effect of including Hynes Bay within the boundaries of Refugio County. Calhoun County did not appeal the judgment and the time for appeal has expired.

In the course of our research on this case we discovered that the General Land Office maps currently and for some time past, include Hynes Bay within the boundaries of Calhoun County. The location of the Bay with respect to the boundaries of these two counties has been the subject of controversy between them for many years and now that the question has finally been resolved, Refugio County would like for the official state maps to reflect the true location of the Bay within its boundaties.

The purpose of this letter then, is to inform you of the result of the above cause and to ask that you advise us as to when the General Land Office maps will begin to reflect this change in the boundaries of Refugio and Calhoun Counties. And also, of course, to ask if there is any additional information we may furnish you or if we may otherwise be helpful in this matter.
