To my personal knowledge, the Commissioners Court of Kaufman County had not approved the Survey reported to them, of first Survey up to 1889. I examined their records myself. So did our Attorneys, more than that. The Clerk of the County Court of Kaufman County told me that the report of the Survey (original) was not on record in his office. The only evidence of the original Survey, that can be found in the records of Kaufman County is an order paying W. H. Barnes, & his assistants for running the line. Our Court made the approval required by law and entered it of Record. Although our records were burned in 1875, I can furnish affidavits of Co. Clerk and Commissioners to prove the truth of the above statements.

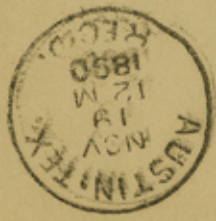
