McGaughey Commissioner of the General Land Office do hereby Certify that the original South boundary line of Hunt County, as shown by data on file in this office, places the South West Corner of said County of Hunt a distance of Nine (9) miles and one thousand and twenty-two (1022) varas south from the South East corner of Collin County which distance places said corner of Hunt about one mile further South than the recent or re-survey made by Bryant Special Surveyor for Kaufman County. I further Certify that the original boundaries of Hunt County on file in this office were legally established

Statement

This line between Rockwall and Kaufman Cos run under instructions from the Commissioner of the General Land Office dated Octob. 3^d 1883 to P. M. Lewis, Special Surveyor of Kaufman Co. and J. A. Pruitt, Special Surveyor of Rockwall Co. and established by ^{the} latter Surveyor has not been approved by this Office, but said instructions were revoked by W. C. Walsh, the Commissioner of the General Land Office and new instructions given, dated January 18/84. which read as follows:

My letter of Octob. 3^d 1883, designating the point at which the S. E. corner of Rockwall County should be located, was based on erroneous data —

By statute the corner is 2 miles South of the S. W. corner of Hunt County and the S. W. corner of Hunt County is 38½ miles South and 25 miles West of the beginning corner (S. W. corner of Lamar Co.) This S. W. corner of Hunt Co. was established in 1882 in accordance with law and is about one mile North of the point, where said corner was delineated on the map from which I took the data —

You will therefore establish the S. W. corner of Hunt County as established in 1882 and run thence as directed in Statute.

The Surveyor of Rockwall Co refusing to assist or taking any part in the Survey, the line was established in April 84 by P. M. Lewis, Special Surveyor of Kaufman County, the field notes of the line were returned to the General Land Office, ^{the said line recognized as the true line between said Cos} approved and the Abstract corrected accordingly and so printed — see Vol. 8.
