White April during the months of July
and September AD 1850 -

Magnetic Meridian 10° East of North
Vernier of Compass $9^{\circ}20'$ N of Mag. Mer.
A point the 85th mile post in the bound-
ary line of Fannin Land District and
the 25th mile post in the South boundary
line thereof as run by Orr in the
months of April and May 1850 from
which the 26th mile post in said line
bears West 80.00 chains, an Oak in branch
10 inches in diameter marked H bears
 $N 56^{\circ} 8' E$ $12 \frac{98}{100}$ chains, an Elm in
branch 9 inches in diameter marked H
bears $N 73^{\circ} 40' E$ $9 \frac{39}{100}$ chains and the
West edge of a small grove of mesquite
bears $S 12^{\circ} 50' West$ about 8 chains.

I certify that the foregoing lines contain
a true description of the Southeast corner
of Collie County as the same appears
on record in the Surveyors Office in
McKinney Collie Co. Texas

to wit John W Sherwood for Rockwall County
" H. Y. Riney Hunt County
and C. W. Hayes of Collin County and
the above named parties then and
there failed to agree

Now these premises considered I would
respectfully ^{submit} the following as my report
1 We disagree as to where the corner
of Collin County is Collin and Rockwall

Contend for the Corner as now established
 now I would call your attention to
 some facts and data in connection
 the Corner is all right so far as
 the Old District line is concerned
 according to the data herewith presented +
 We claim the Corner as the 95 mile
 Post on the Orr line run in
 April and May 1846 and found
 by Geo White Sur of Collin County in
 September 1846 and bearing marked as
 per Exhibit

In our examination We found the brace
 at proper distance but the trees are
 not to be found the Muscicle grove
 is partly remaining if we were controlled
 by it it would move the Corner a
 small distance to the East

The Locality suits for the place very
 well I would further say the Point
 to which Hunt County Claims is nearly
 one mile farther west in open prairie
 no timber near

I nd

We claim the Corner as being near
 the right point because the land office
 has always recognized it as being
 right all of the lands on the west
 of a line running due South from
 the Post were surveyed and patented
 as being in Kaufman or Rockwall
 Counties and would call your attention to

The Calls of Survey no 155 of 544 acres
made for St. Hanna assignee of
John W. H. Stone dated 1861 upon which
the Patent was duly issued
now running north from the N.E.
Corner of Sec 24 we arrive at the
Same Point to wit the one described
in Exhibit B

Now if those Surveys are
right the Corner Post of Collier
County is at the right Point
I would in conclusion from my
own Personal Knowledge ^{say} there never
was until recently any controversy
about this matter it has only
been since this County ^{was} made that
Hunt. set up claim to what we
believe to be a part of our
Territory
