COUNTY OF SAN AUGUSTINE Ø To the Commissioner's Court of San Augustine County
Texas. Whereas at the February Term of the Commissioners Court an order was
passed that the boundary line between San Augustine and Sabine Counties, should
be run by Jas. A. McLaurin County Surveyor of San Augustine County.

BEGINNING at the N.E.cor of San Augustine Co., and continuing
South as far as the Two Counties adjoin. The order says that the work of locating
said boundary line shall begin on the 27 day of May 1912. But to suit the convenience
of the Sabine County Surveyor and by verbal consent of the Court the time was post-
poned until June 19th, 1912.

On the 19th day of June, 1912, I met the surveyor from Sabine
County Mr J.G.Barker at the N.E.cor of San Augustine County, the point designated
to begin work and from that point we proceeded to run said line, just it is given
in the field notes of San Augustine County, as given in Batt's Civil Statutes of
Texas in Vol 1, page 417. We measured the line carefully and set rich pine
posts at the end of each mile and at the corners. The posts were 5ft long and not
less than 8 in. in diameter. We set the posts 3ft in the ground and raised a mound
of earth around each post.

We herewith attach the field notes of said boundary and make them
a part of this report.

BEGINNING at the N.E.cor of ^San Augustine County, it being the N.W. corner of Sabine County and South cor of Shelby County, a post was set and a mound of earth raised. This cor is ^S. $17\frac{1}{4}$ E. $71\frac{1}{2}$ vrs from the N.W. cor of the ^Wm. S. Smith survey on Z. Turner's S.B.line, a sweet gum 36 in in diameter marked C.L.C. brs S 10 E. 5 vrs, a hickory 16 in. in diameter marked C.L.C. brs ^S. $29\frac{1}{4}$ W. $5-1/5$ vrs an elm 12 in. in diameter brs N. $56-3/4$ E. $11-2/5$ vrs;

THENCE due South at 171 vrs a branch at 271 vrs the middle of Clear or Beech creek 12 vrs, wide course N.E. at 451 vrs a branch course N.E. at 790 vrs crossed ^S.B.line of the ^Wm. S. Smith survey at a point N. 73 E. 420 vrs from the S.W.cor of said survey at 1611 vrs, a branch course N.W. at 1791 vrs passed over a ledge of rock at 1901 vrs the 1st mile post a rich pine post 8 in. in diameter, and 5 ft. long was set 3 ft in the ground and a mound of earth raised around it. The post is marked 1 mile end ^San Augustine County on the ^West side and Sabine County on the ^East side on same course at 229 $\frac{1}{4}$ vrs a branch course West at 238 $\frac{1}{4}$ vrs crossed S.B.line of the ^Wm.
