We have the honor to submit the following copies of the field notes of the survey of the boundary lines between the Counties of Shackelford and Stephens and between the Counties of Stephens and Throckmorton in compliance with your order bearing date 13th day of February ad 1879

Beginning at the Meor of Stephens County as established by J. P. Newcomb in 1862 A. D. 6 inches in diameter marked xxx on S side H C I, on N side 1862 on W side and M C on E side from which two a P. O. 16 inches in diameter marked H C I, bears N 29 E 4 1/4 as A. D. O. brs N 41 W 9 1/4 as marks defaced
