

The State of Texas
Dist Starr County

Field notes of the resurvey of the Division line between the Counties of Starr and Hidalgo, pursuant to an order of the Hon County Court of Starr County of date the 1st Monday in September ad 1879, authorizing said resurvey and empowering the undersigned to begin + carry through the work conjointly with the representatives of said County of Hidalgo.

Beginning at a post on north bank of the Rio Grande for the initial point of this Survey: the south east corner of Porcion 100 jurisdiction of Camargo and South west corner of Porcion 71^o 38 jurisdiction of Reynosa as surveyed and marked by Dist Surveyor Starr County in May and June ad 1879. (see Record of said Survey. Book "C" pages 13, 14, and 15 of Records of Surveys Starr Co.)

Thence N 25° E. variation 9° 15' east the course fixed by the law defining County boundaries at 302 varas entered low flat an old

bed of river at 882 v^o crossed Brownsville
Telegraph road running S.E. and on north
side. set post mkd thus $S \frac{1}{4} H$

Thence on same course $N 25^{\circ} E$ through
foot hills & dense chapparal.

at 1900 v^o set post for 1st mile mkd $S \frac{1}{4} H$

" 1950 v^o passed out of range of hills

" 3800 v^o set post for 2^d mile mkd thus $S \frac{1}{2} H$

" 5700 v^o set post for 3^d mile mkd thus $S \frac{3}{4} H$

" 6300 v^o passed small water hole, Charco del Monte

" 7600 v^o set post in dense chapparal for 4th
mile marked thus $S \frac{1}{4} H$

at 9500 v^o 5th mile post mkd thus $S \frac{1}{2} H$

at 9720 v^o line passes west of water hole called
Charco del Melado

at 11400 v^o set hewed mesquite post mkd $S \frac{1}{6} H$ for
6th mile

at 13000 v^o entered brushy prairie

" 13300 v^o on northern edge of brushy prairie
marked 7th mile post thus $S \frac{1}{7} H$

Thence on same course $N 25^{\circ} E$ at 14100 v^o
crossed by road from Las Leueras to San Ramon

at 15200 v^o marked 8th mile post thus $S \frac{1}{8} H$

On same course $N 25^{\circ} E$ through heavy brush

at 17100 v^o set post for 9th mile mkd $S \frac{1}{9} H$

" 19000 v^o mkd 10th mile post thus $S \frac{1}{10} H$

" 20600 v^o line passes into brushy prairie

" 20800 v^o " leaves prairie & enters brush

at 20900 v^o marked post for 11th mile thus $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$
" 21360 v^o line crosses trail from Saladita
to Pecho Noria Cardeña

at 22800 v^o marked post for 12th mile thus $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$
and entered scattering mesquite timber

at 23200 v^o entered Llano de la Daya

at 24700 v^o set post for 13th mile mkd thus $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$

" 26600 v^o set 14th post marked thus $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$

" 28500 v^o set mesquite post on south bound-
ary of a Grant called "Los Maguelles" 1950 v^o
west of S.E. corner thereof for 15th mile
said post mkd $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$

Thence continuing same course $N2.5^{\circ}E$.

at 28100 v^o hill called Alto de "Los Maguelles"

" 29500 v^o entered brushy prairie

" 30400 v^o set post for 16th mile mkd $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$

" 30800 v^o line leaves open Glades & enters mesquite

" 32300 v^o set 17th mile post mkd thus $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$ &
entered open cinizo glade

at 32700 v^o line leaves glade & passes into open
mesquite

at 33100 v^o line enters scrubby undergrowth

at 34200 v^o set post for 18th mile mkd $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$

" 36100 v^o marked 19th post thus $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$

" 38000 v^o set post for 20th mile mkd $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$

" 39900 " set post for 21st mile mkd thus $S\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}H$

" 40690 v^o line crosses South boundary of Tract
called "El Benedito" or gr. Jose Auto Morales
west of its S.E. corner 7390 varas.

- Thence continuing same course $N 25^{\circ} E$.
- at 41800 v. set post for 22^d mile mkd $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{22}$ on edge of Benizo Glade
 - at 42200 v. passed out of said glade
 - at 43610 v. crossed water hole called "Charco de Coostillas"
 - at 43700 v. set post mkd for 23^d mile $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{23}$
 - " 44120 v. entered small drain or Derramedera
 - " 44300 v. left Derramedera & entered Chaparral
 - " 45600 v. set post for 24th mile mkd thus $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{24}$
 - " 47100 v. an Ebony grove. called Alto de Las Mestizas
 - " 47600 v. crossed P. G. City & Salt Lake Trail - 52
 - " 47700 v. set post for 25th mile mkd thus $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{25}$
 - " 48500 v. passed Charco de Las Mestizas west of line
 - at 49100 v. entered bottom covered with Mesquite
 - at 49400 v. set post mkd for 26th mile thus $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{26}$
 - " 50200 v. entered Abra de Agua Sarca
 - " 50500 v. left abra into heavy brush
 - " 50600 v. Alto Colorado, open mesquite
 - " 51300 v. set post for 27th mile mkd thus $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{27}$
 - " 52600 v. line crosses San Ramon & Luerns road
 - at 53200 v. set post for 28th mile mkd thus $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{28}$
 - at 55100 v. set post for 29th mile mkd thus $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{29}$
 - Thence on same course through scattering mesquite Timber - $N 25^{\circ} E$
 - at 57000 v. set post for 30th mile mkd thus $\frac{S \overline{D} H}{30}$
 - " 57500 v. left Timber and Chaparral and

entered bald open prairie, slightly rolling.

at 58750 v^s crossed trail from Sal Colorado to Salt Lake

at 58900 set post for 31st mile mkd thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 31 \end{matrix}$

" 59400 v. entered thicket called El Jarili

" 60100 v line again enters rolling prairie

" 60800 v set post for 32^d mile mkd thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 32 \end{matrix}$

" 61636 v. passed trail from Santa Cruz to San Ramon

" 62400 v set post for 33^d mile mkd thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 33 \end{matrix}$ in thicket of small mesquite brush

at 64600 set post for 34th mile mkd thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 34 \end{matrix}$

from which a post rock the north west corner of the San Ramon tract original grantee Julian Farias bears $N 75^{\circ} 15' E 1339$ v^s

Thence continuing same course $N 25^{\circ} E$

at 66500 v set post for 35th mile mkd thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 35 \end{matrix}$

" 68400 v set post for 36th mile mkd thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 36 \end{matrix}$

" 70300 v^s set post in prairie for 37th mile marked thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 37 \end{matrix}$

at 72200 v. set 38th post mkd thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 38 \end{matrix}$

at 74100 v set post for 39th mile mkd thus $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 39 \end{matrix}$

" 74500 v^s crossed trail in prairie from La Buena to San Jose

at 75900 v. passed between two small live oak motts bearing $E 400$ v^s and $W 700$ varas

at 76000 v set post mkd $\begin{matrix} S \text{ } \Delta \text{ } H \\ 40 \end{matrix}$ for 40th mile

" 76200 entered live oak brush in tract

called San Antonio

at 77200 r. passed out of brush at a pond of sweet water

at 77900 r. mtd post for 41st mile ^{S 84° W}₄₁

at 78100 r. ² crossed Arroyo de Los Vacas, 80 r. wide

at 78700 r. passed west of Laguna de las Cuatas near the line

at 79800 r. set post for 42^d mile mtd thus ^{S 84° W}₄₂

at 81400 r. set post for 43^d mile mtd thus ^{S 84° W}₄₃

at 83600 r. set post for 44th mile mtd thus ^{S 84° W}₄₄

at 85500 r. set post for 45th mile mtd thus ^{S 84° W}₄₅

at 87300 r. a lone mesquite in prairie called "Mesquite del Linderó" bears W. 73 varas

at 87400 r. passed on to brushy table land or high ridge called "La mesa de San Francisco" where set post for 46th mile mtd thus ^{S 84° W}₄₆ from which a stone the north west corner of the Rucia Tract original grantee Guadalupe Sanchez bears. South 46° 30' West 2377 varas.

Thence through and over said ridge continuing same course viz N 25° E.

at 89300 r. set post for 47th mile mtd thus ^{S 84° W}₄₇

at 91200 r. set post for 48th mile mtd thus ^{S 84° W}₄₈

at 93100 r. set post for 49th mile mtd thus ^{S 84° W}₄₉

at 93875 r. crossed road from Gonzalina to Palomas

at 93900 r. left brushy ridge and entered Prairie

at 95000 v^o set post mkd $S^{57}H$ for 50th mile
at 96900 v^o set post for 51st mile mkd thus $S^{58}H$
at 98800 v^o set post for 52^d mile mkd thus $S^{59}H$
at 100590 v^o Pipequazo. Ranch in Preemption
made for Berildo Barroa bears East 2384 v^o
at 100700 v^o set post for 53^d mile on southern
border of Live oak timber called "El Encinal"
Thence through dense Live oak brush
and heavy oak timber on same course
N 25° E.

at 102600 v^o set post for 54th mile mkd thus $S^{60}H$
at 104500 v^o set post for 55th mile mkd thus $S^{61}H$
at 106400 v^o set post for 56th mile mkd thus $S^{62}H$
at 108300 v^o set post for 57th mile mkd thus $S^{63}H$
at 110200 v^o set post for 58th mile mkd thus $S^{64}H$
at 112100 v^o set post for 59th mile mkd thus $S^{65}H$
at 114000 v^o set post for 60th mile mkd thus $S^{66}H$
at 115900 v^o set post for 61st mile mkd thus $S^{67}H$
at 117800 v^o set post for 62nd mile mkd thus $S^{68}H$
at 119700 v^o set post for 63^d mile mkd thus $S^{69}H$

from whence the South East corner of
Guadalupe tract original grantee Leonard
Vargas. bears North 60° 30' West 15321 v^o.

at 120650 v^o passed out of Live oak timber
or "Encinal" and entered salt prairie
of Laguna Blanca

Thence through bald prairie on same
course N 25° E.

at 121600 v^o set post for 64th mile mkd thus $S^{70}H$

at 123500 v. set post for 65th mile mtd thus ^{S 124 H}₆₅

at 125400 v. set post for 66th mile mtd thus ^{S 125 H}₆₆

at 127300 v. set post for 67th mile mtd thus ^{S 126 H}₆₇

from whence the South west corner of Survey
 71^o 289. in name of Felipe Alvarez bears
 S 16¹/₄ W. 1120 v. and a post on south bank
 of Laguna Blanca the South west corner
 of Tract called Loma Blanca and south
 East corner of Tract called Los Olmos of
 Loma Blanca in name of Ignacio Peña
 bears North 59^o 15' East 1802 varas.

Thence continuing same course N 25^o E
 through alternate stretches of mesquite
 thickets and grassy prairies

at 128620 v. line enters bed of arroyo de Baluarte
 400 v. wide at this point

at 129200 v. set post for 68th mile mtd thus ^{S 127 H}₆₈
 in heavy mesquite thicket called "Rincon
 de Los Indios"

at 130800 v. crossed mesquite creek

at 131100 v. set post for 69th mile mtd thus ^{S 128 H}₆₉

at 133000 v. set post for 70th mile mtd thus ^{S 129 H}₇₀

on bank of large Salt Inlet one of the
 branches of Laguna Blanca

at 134900 v. set post for 71st mile mtd thus ^{S 130 H}₇₁

at 135700 v. crossed road from Loma Blanca
 to Los Olmos NNE

at 136800 v. set post for 72^d mile mtd thus ^{S 131 H}₇₂

at 138,900 v^o set post for 73^d mile in small
 field between Carrizos & Caballos Ranches
 said post marked thus $S\frac{N}{73}E$
 at 138,840 v^o crossed Arroyo de Los Olmos
 at 140,600 v^o set post for 74th mile mkd thus $S\frac{N}{74}E$
 at 142,500 v^o set post for 75th mile mkd thus $S\frac{N}{75}E$
 and at 143,165 varas intersected south
 boundary of Nueces County in the Tract
 of land called "El Paisano" $S88\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}E$
 1620.5 varas from the south west corner
 of Nueces and south east corner of
 Dural. County; and set a mesquite
 hewed post mkd as follows. $S\frac{N}{75\frac{1}{2}}E$ being
 the North east corner of this County
 and North west corner of Hidalgo County
 as determined by this Survey.
