Field Notes of a survey of the County line dividing counties of Starr and Hidalgo made by order of the County Court of Starr County March 20<sup>th</sup> 1878 in accordance with the provisions of an Act of the legislature of this State approved April 30. 1870 in which said boundary is particularly defined

Beginning at the point designated in said "Act" as the ranch of "Las Cuevas" former jurisdiction line dividing Reynosa and Camargo at being the South East corner of old survey "Porcion" 102 a post set on bank of river from which a mesquite tree bears  $N 8^{\circ} 30' W$  17,510 varas marked NK and an Ebony tree bears  $N 11^{\circ} E$  29,510 varas in the Rancho of "Las Cuevas" Thence  $N 25^{\circ} E$  at 2300 varas to road from Rio Grande City to Brownsville post 3 1/2 feet high set on south side of road and marked with 2300 and SC-HC + CL same course at 5000 set post marked + numbered for 1 league post at 10000 varas set post marked + numbered for 2 league at 12863 post set on south side of road from La Yoya to Las Cuevas bearing SW at 15000 varas set post 4 feet high marked + numbered for 3 league post at 20000 varas set post on bedrock cutting

the letter W in the same and planting post  
on it by surrounding it with a mound of  
stones - at 22700 varas road from La Joya  
to San Ramon bearing west of north at  
24600 varas road from Rancho Cardenera  
to the Ranch of the Grulla course N. 5° W  
at 25000 varas set post for 5 leagues - at  
28700 varas the south boundary of a  
Survey in the name of Segundo Flores called  
Las Guages - at 30000 varas set post for  
6 leagues marked and numbered  
at 35000 set post for 7 leagues marked  
and numbered  
at 40000 varas set post marked and  
numbered for 8 leagues at 41500 varas  
crossed the north boundary line of the  
Segundo Flores survey and at 43250 passed  
the south boundary line of a survey in  
name of Jose Antonio Morales Garcia called  
"El Bendito" at 45000 varas set post for  
9 leagues. marked and numbered at 50000  
post marked & numbered for 10 leagues  
at 51115 post on N. E. side of road to Salt  
Lake from Laredo at 52300 crossed the line  
of the Morales Garcia survey. and south line  
of a survey in name of Alexander Faras. at  
53000 varas set post for 11 leagues at 55400

varas passed the East boundary line of the Alexander Pucias Survey - at 60000 varas post marked and numbered for 12 leagues at 65000 varas post marked and numbered for 13 leagues at 70000 varas post set and marked for 14 leagues at 72000 varas crossed western boundary line of a survey in name of Guadalupe Sanchez called "Las Pucias" - at 75000 varas set post for 15 leagues at 80000 varas post set for 16 leagues marked and numbered at 85000 varas post set and numbered for 17 leagues crossed the East boundary line of the Sanchez survey at 89400 passed the south boundary line of a survey in name Jose Man<sup>e</sup> Chapa called "La Encantada" at 90.000 varas set post for 18 leagues at 93000 crossed the East boundary line of the Jose Man<sup>e</sup> Chapa survey and the west boundary line of adjoining survey in name of "Luciano Chapa" called "El Encino del Pozo" at 95000 varas post for 19 leagues at 100.000 varas post for 20 leagues at 103.200 varas crossed north boundary line of the Luciano Chapa Survey. at 105000 varas set post for 21 leagues marked and numbered at 110.000 varas post for 22 leagues at 115000 post set for 23 leagues at 120000 varas post for 24 leagues marked & numbered

at 125000 varas post set for 25 leagues marked  
and numbered at 130000 varas post set  
for 26 leagues marked & numbered at 133  
000. south boundary line of a survey in  
name of Frans<sup>co</sup> Guerra Chapa also the  
south shore of the Laguna Loma Blanca  
at 134000 left Laguna at 135000 post set  
for 27 leagues at 139,200 crossed Olmos  
Creek 25 varas wide course south East  
at 140000 varas set post for 28 leagues marked  
and numbered. at 145000 post set for  
29 leagues. at 145,300 the north boundary  
line of the Guerra Chapa Survey, and  
south boundary of survey in name of Ramon  
Garcia called 'El Paisano' also the Paisano  
Creek bearing S<sup>6</sup>E at 145543.570 varas  
intersected the south boundary line of  
Nueces County due East 8964 varas from  
the south west corner of Nueces County  
post set 3 feet high 3 square and marked  
N. H. C. - S. C. from which a mesquite  
alone by itself bears N 50 1/2 W 250 varas  
marked N. This Survey began June 28<sup>th</sup> 1848
