Whereupon amongst other proceedings
the following were had to wit

(Extract)

" Whereas it is provided by an act entitled an
" act establishing and prescribing the manner
" of ascertaining the boundary of Comaltes passed
" by the sixteenth Legislature of the State of
" Texas, and approved April 22/879, General
" law of the regular session of the sixteenth
" Legislature of 1879 on page 187, and
" Whereas in conformity with said act
" aforesaid, it has been made known to the
" satisfaction of this Court that the
" boundary line between the County of

" Hidalgo and Starr have not been sufficient, ~~definite~~ and well defined,
nor has the same been surveyed according
to law. Therefore it is hereby ordered by
this Court, that James L. Dougherty be
appointed Surveyor in accordance with
with said act aforesaid, upon his comp-
pliance in taking the oath of office as
prescribed by law for County Surveyors,
before entering upon the prescribed by said
act aforesaid, and enter into bond with
two or more securities in the sum of One
Thousand dollars, payable to the County
Judge or his successors in office, and
approved by this Court, Condition for
the faithful performance of his
duties. The duties of said Surveyor
shall be to ascertain by actual
Survey the boundary or any part
therof of said county, and to make
and to establish the line and
corners as prescribed by said act
aforesaid. It is further ordered by
this Court, that the Surveyor shall
begin to run said County line
between said Counties of Hidalgo,
and Starr on the margin of the Rio
Grande at the Rancho Las Cienegas.

" at the point formerly dividing the
ancient jurisdiction of the towns
of Raynora and Carmago, thence
to run north twenty five degrees
east, so as to intersect the south
line of Nance County, defined in
article 5.866 P. & D vol 2, that the
corners to be established and marked
shall in all things conform to the
laws defining the boundaries of
said County. That the field notes of
the survey of the line herein ordered
to be surveyed, by the surveyor
shall give an accurate description
of all prominent natural objects
crossed by or adjacent to said line
as well as of the corners, and lines
of surveys on or near said boundary
and to make due return of the
field notes and maps to this Court
and to comply in all things, and
in the manner required in said
act aforesaid, and it is further
ordered that James L. Daugherty
Surveyor hereby appointed shall
proceed and commence said
survey on said dividing line
between the Counties aforesaid

on the 25th day of November A. D. 1889
at a place where a post is set out on
main road from the town of
Hidalgo to Rio Grande City, which
post is marked on the West side
N^o. 100, "C" and on the East side
marked N^o. 88 "R" which post
denoting the jurisdiction of the
parishes of Carrizozo and
Reynosa. It is further ordered
that the Clerk of this Court transmitt
by mail to the County Commissioners
Court of San Juan County a certified
copy of these proceedings - - - - -
The Bond of James S. Daugherty
being presented to the Court, and
the Court being satisfied therewith,
the same was approved

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Hidalgo, January 15th 1880
To the Hon. Commissioners Court
of Hidalgo County, Texas
Gentlemen

I have the
honor to report to your Hon. body
that in conformity of your Order
issued October 27th 1879. I repaired
to Las Cuevas, on the 26th day of No-
vember 1879, and there met J. C. Everett,
Surveyor of Starr County, who
we then proceeded to the margin
of the Rio Grande, to a place, where,
the original jurisdiction of the Towns
of Reynosa and Camargo, on this side
of said river began, from which
place we ran the line as far as the
main road. It being impossible
to continue the line at that time, on
account of having been unable
to obtain laborers to continue
the line, we adjourned the work
to the 1st day of December, at which
time everything would be ready to
continue the work.

On the 1st of December, I repaired
to Las Cuevas, in company of Andres Salinas

who represented J. C. Eives, and the
Line was continued from that
day till January 7th 1880, when it
was completed.

Not having in my possession the field
notes of Porciones Nos. 38, 39 and 40. I
am unable to state the quantity of land
situated in this County. Of "Los
Magueyes" about $\frac{1}{3}$ of the amount remains
in this County. Of "Los Guajes" tract
all, but a small fraction.

From this on to the end of the line
several tracts of land were crossed by the
County Line; but, I am unable to
make correct statements of the quantity
of land, remaining in this County,
such as "El Venadito" Santa Cruz.
San Jose" "El Ruscio" Ignacio Peñas,
and a vast amount of vacant lands
traversed by the line, on which are
some locations. All field notes, and
maps, of which are not registered in my
Office, as these lands were surveyed
by the Surveyors of Starr County.

Only three streams of water were
crossed by the line, namely - Palo
Blanco, and Mesquit creeks, saltily, trib-
utaries of Loma Blanca Lagoon.

The whole distance surveyed from
The margin of the Rio Grande to the
place where said line made corner
with the County line of Hueres
County is 143.165 varas, or 75 miles
665 varas.
