

The State of Texas. I, J.W. Brown Specie
leometry of Stephens & Surveyor of Stephens County
Texas do hereby certify concerning the establish-
ment of the North East corner of Stephens
County Texas, at a point in the South line of
Young Co. 30 miles West of the West line of
Parker County, that to ascertain and find said
point in the South line of Young Co. I began
at the North West corner of Parker County which
I found to be a hewn mesquite Post about 4
inches square now much decayed and split
into two pieces, on one of which was P and
on the other N . This post was lying on the ground
and near it had been erected a stake and was named
a Post Day about 15 inches in diameter facing and
marked "VWC PC N 19 E 84 1/2 S 19 W
84 1/2. The peckers were here pecking holes in the
tree destroying a post of the first tier (N) and the
lower post of the tier P . There a post of the tier
of in CDR were grown over, leaving only what is
above given showing. A dead mesquite stump
that did not bear any mesquitos bears 87 1/2 E 30 1/2.
The S.E. corner of P.E. & L Co Sur. No 2568 identified
by both its bearing bears 880 1/2 E 456.6 m and the
South West corner of this survey identified by one
of its bearing ~~is~~ is 1344 m West of the S.E. cor.
the due north line runs south from the ~~South~~
above described corner.

A thorough search was made at and around a
point N 80 1/2 E 457 m from the S.W. cor. said survey
2568 P.E. & L Co. but no trace of any corner could
be found. It was shown the above described
corner by an old gunner named Mr. Price
upon whose premises it is situated who claims
to have lived by and known this corner since

about the time it was established and that the post shown me was the one first seen by him soon after the establishment of said corner.

From this point I ran West 30 miles and South
3 miles and 533 rods to a point in the South line
of Young Co. for the North West corner of Palo
Pinto and the North East corner of Stephens
County. The distance from North West corner
of Parker County was carefully measured by
experienced chainmen, who were kept in front
of the transit the front chainmen carrying a
rod by which he was brought in line before
laying down the measure of each chain.
