

## Statement.

On the accompanying sketch the black lines indicate the boundaries of the several Counties as originally defined by the acts of the 7th Legislature 1855, according to which Stephens Co (then called Buchanan Co) begins at the N.W. corner of Palo Pinto Co. thence West 30 miles - thence South 30 miles etc.

Shackelford Co. begins at the N.W. corner of Stephens Co. thence West 30 miles thence South 30 miles etc.

Brown Co. runs with the S.W. line of Comanche Co. to its West corner - thence West 16 miles etc. Coleman Co. runs to the N.W. corner of Brown Co. thence West 30 miles etc.

Eastland Co. begins at the S.W. corner of Stephens Co. thence South to the Northline of Brown Co - no distance given - to

Callahan Co. begins at the N.W. corner of Eastland Co - thence West 30 miles - thence South to the Northline of Coleman Co - no distance given - etc.

Provided: If Eastland, Callahan & Taylor Cos do not contain 900 squ. miles their Westline shall be extended so as to contain said number of sq. miles.

It was found that Eastland and Callahan Cos did not contain 900 sqm. miles and therefore their Westline was moved farther West as indicated on sketch. The 15th Legislature 1876 changed Eastland Co. by beginning at the S.W. corner of Stephens Co. thence South 30 miles and in like manner Callahan and Taylor Counties were made 30 miles square, encroaching thereby on Brown, Coleman and Burnet Co's as shown on sketch in red ink.

As the other lines, except the Westline of Eastland Co, were not changed, the distance of 30 miles for the Westline of said Co. does not tally with the other lines of the County, and this seems to cause the trouble about the line between Eastland and Stephens Co.

The 15 Legislature 1876 changed Eastland Co. by beginning at the ~~south corner~~<sup>west corner</sup> of Stephens Co. thence South 30 miles ~~and in like manner~~<sup>also</sup> Callahan Co. also Callahan Co and Taylor Co were made 30 miles square encroaching on Brown, Coleman and Rummel Cos as shown on sketch in red ink.

As the other lines of Eastland Co were not changed, it seems the North line of Brown Co. establishing the Eastland Co line and a line east north some 30 miles the distance of 30 miles for the west line of Eastland Co will not tally with the other lines of the County and this seems to cause the trouble about the line between Eastland & Stephens Co.

 Stephens Co. thence West 30 miles - thence South 30 miles etc.  
 Brown runs with the line of Comanche Co. to its N.W. corner - thence West  
 16 miles etc. Coleman Co. runs to the N.W. corner of Brown Co. - thence West  
 30 miles etc.

Eastland Co. begins at the S.W. corner of Stephens Co. - thence South to the N line of  
 Brown Co. (no distance given) etc.

Callahan Co. begins at the N.W. corner of Eastland Co. thence West 30 miles / thence  
 South to the Northline of Coleman Co. (no distance given) etc.

Provided: If the Eastland, Callahan & Taylor Cos. do not contain 900 sq. miles  
their Westline shall be extended so as to contain said number of sq. miles.  
 It was found that the latter Counties did not contain 900 sq. miles  
 and therefore the Westline was moved further West. as indicated on the sketch.
