Dear Sir

I forward you the plots and field notes to day of the N. & W. boundary of Stonewall County. The Surveyor of King County did not come I done the work alone the N. W. Corner of Haskell Co is about 6440rs North of the South East Corner of Dickens Co or it shows to be so by the survoys I find B.K.F. has been badly surveyed it was located by the needle and I find for 10 miles N and 10 miles West from the beginning of B.K.F. the needle will often vary as much as three degrees in running one mile I run out 1200rs south of South E. corner of Dickens Co but called for the corner in my field notes, but if that distance is too great I will go back and correct it & the Kent Co. surveyor got to South East Corner of Dickens on time but I was water bound and he did not wait for me he run south but as he made no sign cut no brush or anything else I could not accept his line I run the west line of our Co and marked it properly and I am confident you will find it correct. The Kent Co Surveyor run with an open sight Compass and Jacob Staff and of course varied sometimes I would be near his pile of Dirt and at the next one perhaps 300rs apart and his chainmen were careless their work was bad. They found an old fence post 945rs before they reached N. Line of Fisher and set their corner from that &

- 8th Thence west on 8th Mile at 400 vs a branch at 450 vs branch at 540 vs a creek at 1000 vs top of hill at 1900, $\frac{8}{10}$ a cedar post marked on S. side S. 8. M. and on N side K. 8. - 17 Thence W on 17th mile at 1400^{rs} was a Mes post marked S. 17, M on south side and K. 17, M on North side from which the East point of Double Mountain brs S. 18³/₄ W.
- 18th Thence W on 18th mile at 900^{rs} was a canyon at 1120^{rs} branch at 1400^{rs} was a Mes post marked S. 18, M on south side and K. 18, M on North side set on west side of a branch
- 19th Thence W on 19th mile at 1850^{rs} was a deep gip canyon at 1900^{rs} was a cedar post set on west bank of canyon marked S. 19, M on south side and K. 19, M on N side
- 20th Thence West on 20th mile at 475^{rs} was a deep canyon at 740^{rs} a creek at 1400^{rs} was a cedar post marked S. 20, M on South side and K. 20, M. on N. side set at the foot of a high bluff

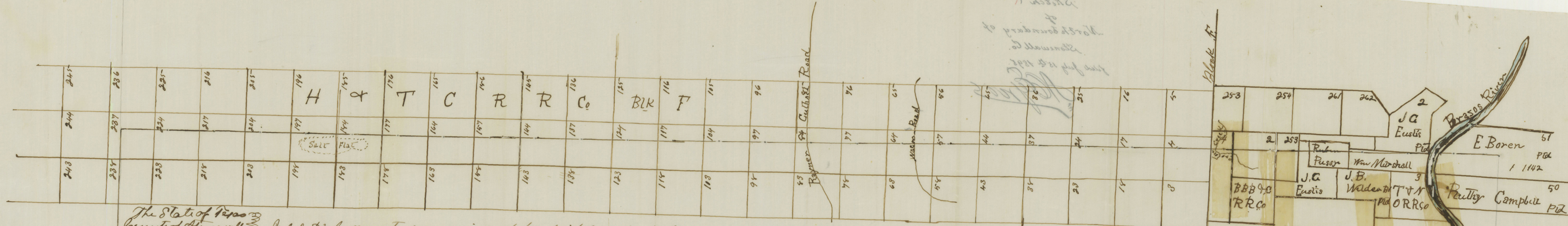
