Beginning at a Mes post 4 inches square
 Marked X on East and West sides with 4 pits .8
 feet apart and mound of dirt around post
 said post was set for the S.E. corner of Dickens
 County and is 6956⁸/10 vs North and 3223 vs East of the
 South West Cor of Blk F and the N.W. cor Blk D H &
 T.C.R.R. Co's Survey said post is on section No 257 and
 is 644 vs S. of It line and 577 vs W. of East line of
 said section.

1st Thence South on first Mile at 1900⁸/10 vs a Mes post
 Marked on East side W.L.S.C. set on top of high hill
 from which an Earth mound brs W. 10 vs

2nd Thence South on 2nd Mile crossing three deep
 Canyons at 1900⁸/10 vs a Mes post Marked on East
 side W.L.S. 2 M and on West side K 2 M

3rd Thence South on 3rd Mile at 400 vs deep canyon 500
 vs canyon at 1900⁸/10 vs a Mes post Marked on E. side
 W.L.S. 3 M. from which the west point of Double Mountain
 brs S. 10^E

4th Thence South on 4th Mile at 1256 vs N line of sec
 No 432 Blk D H & T.C.R.R. at a point 3223 vs E. of the
 N.W. cor Blk D. at 1900⁸/10 vs a concrete stone set
 in fork of a Canyon

5th Thence South on fifth Mile at 116 vs a deep
 Canyon at 520 vs an old wagon road at 1900⁸/10
 vs a Mes post Marked W.L.S. 4 M on east side set
 in low Mes flat

6th Thence South on sixth Mile at 1800 vs a Canyon at
 1900⁸/10 vs a Mes post on N bank of south coton
 post Marked W.L.S. 6 M.

7th Thence South on 7th Mile at 70 vs bank of coton
 Creek at 920 vs South bank of creek at 1900⁸/10

was a mes post on top of ridge marked W.L.S. 7.M. on east side.

8th Hence South on 8th Mile at 100 was a canyon at 1600 was a canyon at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post set on North slope of hill from which the Kent County Surveyors 8th Mill Mound lies South $28\frac{3}{4}$ W. 54° N. End on red hill lies N. $24\frac{1}{2}$ W.

9th Hence South on 9th Mile at 1520 was cross deep canyon at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post set on south bank of small canyon marked on East side W.L.S. 9.M.

10th Hence South on 10th Mile at 550 was a canyon at 1100 was a canyon at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post marked W.L.S. 10.M. on East side set on west bank of China canyon from which a China lies S. 7.2° N. 11th Hence South on 11th Mile at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post marked W.L.S. 11.M. set in thick mesquit brush.

12th Hence South on 12th Mile at 1980 was the Raynor and Dayton Road at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post marked W.L.S. 12.M.

13th Hence South on 13th Mile at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post on South side of a sand hill marked W.L.S. 13.M. from which the East point of Double Mountain lies S. $28\frac{1}{2}$ E.

14th Hence South on 14th Mile at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post set in the shiny post marked W.L.S. 14.M. the West point of Double Mountain Mountain lies S. $29\frac{1}{2}$ E.

15th Hence South on 15th Mile at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post in shiny marked W.L.S. 15.M. on East side from which a large flat rock on North side of Double Mountain lies S. $26\frac{1}{2}$ E.

16th Hence South on 16th Mile at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ was a mes post marked W.L.S. 16.M. set in shiny from which the East end of Double Mountain lies South $37\frac{1}{2}$ E.

- 17th Thence South on 17th Mile at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post set in Shinner. Marked on East side W.L.S. 17.M from which the east point of Double Mountain lies S. 41 $\frac{3}{4}$ E.
- 18th Thence South on the 18th Mile at 8,70 m.s. North bank of Salt fork of Payette River course South 75 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. at 1120 m.s. South bank of River at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post marked W.L.S. 18.M set in valley
- 19th Thence South on 19th Mile at 1520 m.s. a deep canyon at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post marked W.L.S. 19.M set on North slope of hill
- 20th Thence South on 20th Mile at 9,75 m.s. a post marked W.L.S.C. set on side of Raynor and Clairmont road at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post marked W.L.S. 20.M from which the W. end of Double Mountain lies S. 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.
- 21st Thence South on 21st Mile at 480 m.s. Stinking Creek at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post marked W.L.S. 21.M
- 22nd Thence South on 22nd Mile at 12,56 m.s. South line of Section No. 4, 15. Blk D. H & F.C. R.R. Co's and 8170 m.s. East from the S.W. Cor Blk D. and N.W. Cor of section No. 1, W.C.R.R. Co. at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post set on West slope of hill marked W.L.S. 22.M
- 23rd Thence South on 23rd Mile at 12,56 m.s. South line of Section No. 2, W.C.R.R. Co land at 1600 m.s. a road at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post from which the West end of Double Mountain lies N. 85 $\frac{8}{9}$ E.
- 24th Thence South on 24th Mile at 14,00 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post marked W.L.S. 24.M
- 25th Thence South on 25th Mile at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post marked W.L.S. 25.M set in South Slope of hill from which West end of Double Mountain lies N. 60 $\frac{8}{9}$ E.
- 26th Thence South on 26th Mile at 1900 $\frac{8}{10}$ m.s. a mes post marked W.L.S. 26.M set on South Slope of hill in fork of two big canyons

- 37th Thence South on 27th Mile at 8.90 vs bed of creek
 at 1780 vs deep canyon at 1900 $\frac{1}{2}$ vs a mes post
 Marked W.L.S. 27, M from which West End of Double
 Mountain brs N. 40 E. east point brs of D.M. brs
 N. 48, E
- 38th Thence South on 28th Mile at 1900 $\frac{1}{2}$ vs a mes post
 set on East slope of hill Marked W.L.S. 28, M,
- 39th Thence South on 29th Mile at 7.50 vs a deep Canyon
 at 1800 vs a canyon at 1900 $\frac{1}{2}$ vs a mes post
 Marked W.L.S. 29, M from which the west point of
 Double Mountain brs at 30, E
- 30th Thence South on 30th Mile at 11.80 vs a cedar post
 set in North line of Fisher Co. Marked on East side
 S.W.C.S.C. on west side S.E.K.C. from which two cotton-
 woods 14 in dia Marked S.E.K.C. (old marks), brs 8, 89 $\frac{1}{4}$
 East 325 vs said post is on section No 308 Blk
 No 2 H & T.R.R. Co's survy and is South 17 W 750 vs
 from N.E. cor of said section and is 500 vs
 W. of the <sup>22nd ~~21st~~ Mile stone going West on Fisher
 County line</sup>
