27th Thence W. on 27th Mile at 100 was the salt flat and Dickens road at 950 was deep canyon at 1900⁸/₁₀ was a Mound of gip rock in small Canyon

28th Thence W. on 28th Mile at 375 was Crosses dove Creek again at 1900⁸/₁₀ was a gip stone set in head of small Canyon from which three Mes marked X by N 53 E 44 W

29th Thence W. on 29th Mile at 400 was a Canyon at 1900⁸/₁₀ was a Mound and two pits in prairie Valley

30th Thence W. on 30th Mile at 768 was Crosses Canyon at a Hackberry Marked 4 backs on south side at 1993 was a Mes. post 4 inches square Marked X on E, W sides set for the S. E. corner of Dickes Co and is set on section No 237, B.R.F., H.V.T., C.R.R. Co. and is 644 was South of the North line and 577 was West of the east line of said section

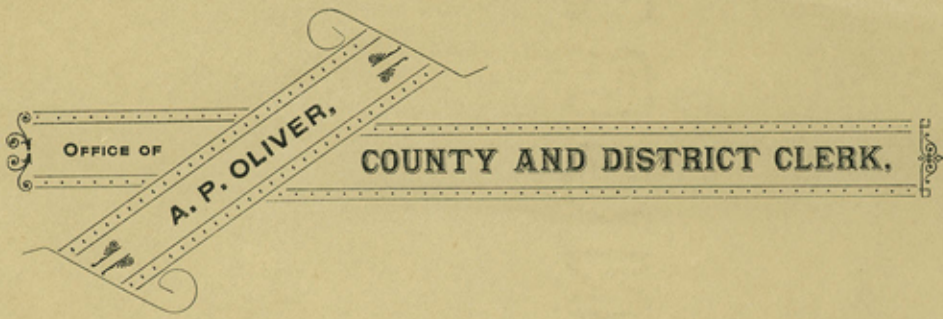

Dear Sir

our clerk will forward you plot and field notes of north line of this county this morning as corrected, and I think you will find them correct. The South East cor of Dickens County is 10.36 rods South of the N.W. cor of Haskell County and the Haskell line was run at 9.1' at the corner so I had to turn off 1.1' to make my line connect the two corners My line however crosses section lines but I hit the corner of Dickens County exactly

I hope you will find work correct and report to me as soon as convenient.

I sent corrected field notes of west line and copy of agreement between me and Mr Harder some time ago &c
