It appearing to the satisfaction of the County Court of Tarrant County that the South boundary line of Tarrant County (to-wit the line between Tarrant and Ellis Counties and between Tarrant and Johnson Counties) is not sufficiently definite and well defined. And it further appearing to the said Court that J.J. Goodfellow, of Tarrant County is an experienced and competent practical surveyor; it is therefore ordered that the said J.J. Goodfellow be and he is hereby appointed to ascertain by actual survey the South boundary line of Tarrant County (to-wit the line between Tarrant and Ellis Counties and the line between Tarrant and Johnson Counties) and to establish and mark the South East corner of Tarrant County. And further ordered that he make and establish the said line and corner in the manner provided by Chapter 4 of title 22 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Texas, and the amendments thereto. And further ordered that he make due return of the field notes and map of the line and corner so established, to the County Court as provided by law.

Further ordered that said J.J. Goodfellow before entering upon the discharge of his duties under this appointment, give bond in the sum of \$1000.00

conditioned and payable as required by law in such cases and that he take the oath of office required by law of County Surveyors. And it is further ordered that the said J.J. Goodfellow commence to run, make, establish and mark said line and corner on the 17th day of Nov A.D. 1891 at 11 o'clock A.M. on said day at the South West corner of Dallas County. And it is further ordered that a copy of this order be sent to the County Court of Johnson County and a copy be sent to the County Court of Ellis County as required by law.
