To the Honorable Commissioners Court of
Tom Green County,

Gentlemen; By virtue of an
order of your Honorable Court made on the 8th
day of Sept. A.D. 1891 appointing me Special
Surveyor for Tom Green County to begin at
the S.E. corner of said County on Nov. 16th 1891
and survey and establish the South boundary
line of Tom Green County so far as the same
joins Schleicher County, I surveyed as follows
to-wit;

Co. the S.W. corner of Concho Co., the N.W. cor. of
Menard Co. and the N.E. corner of Schleicher Co. a
large stone monument capped with a stone marked

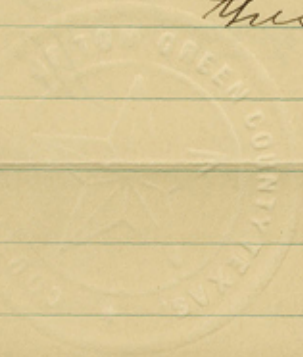

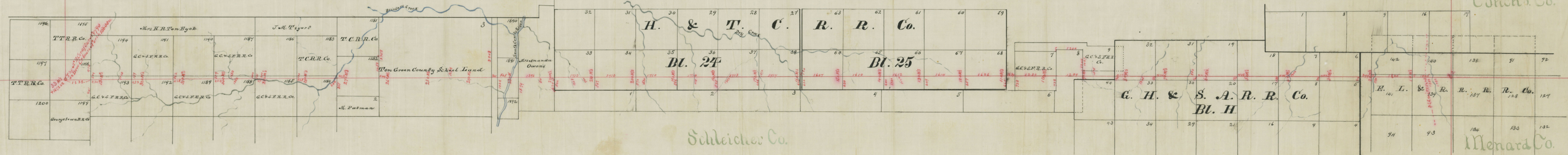
