

1 San Angelo, Texas Dec. 14th 1891.
2 To the Honorable Commissioners Court
3 of Tom Green County, Texas.

4 Gentlemen: By virtue of
5 an order of your Honorable Court, passed
6 on the 10th day of November, A.D. 1891, appointing
7 me Special Surveyor, to assist in surveying
8 and establishing the South line of Coke Co. it
9 being a portion of the North boundary line of
10 Tom Green County, Texas. After having given bond
11 and qualified as the law directs, I proceeded to the
12 S. W. Corner of Coke County on the date ordered and
13 there met Mr. J. R. Patterson, County Surveyor of
14 Coke Co. and we jointly surveyed as follows to-wit:

1 Beginning at a stone monument marked

16 from which Golgotha Mt. bears N 45° W. Hay Stack Hill

20 Thence East at 1124 varas cross the N.W. line
21 of Sur. No. 254 Head River 1250 varas S 35° W from the upper
22 River Cor. of said survey at 1835 varas cross Mulberry Creek
23 at 1900 varas a stone monument marked I M. T. G & C
24 COLINE from which a Pec. 17' bears N 25° 20' W 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ vs.

20 and Sterling City road marked CO LINE from
21 which the 26 miles east on said road bears North 26 vs.

23 Thence East at 412 vs cross the East
line of said Sur. No. 61 and W. line of No 62 O.M.R.R.C.
339 vs. South from their North common corner at
1052 vs. cross San Angelo and Haysick road at 1115
vs. cross Red Creek about 4 hours below Spring 1900 vs
stone monument on divide marked 23 Ms T.G.&C.C.O.

All calls for survey lines are given, either from
actual measurements made to their corners, or, where
no corners were found, from calculations made after
having made connections to the nearest practicable
corner, with which such surveys connect.
