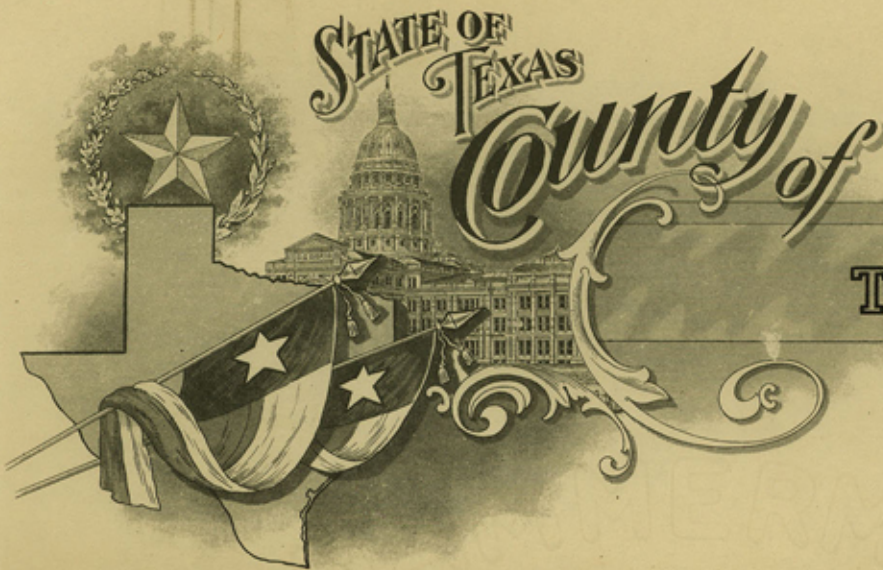

Dear Mr. Walker: I herewith return certified copy of field notes and Plat of recent survey of boundary lines between Burnet, Blanco, Hays and Travis Counties.

It was returned to me for a change in the certificate, Mr. Homeyer stating that your Department refused to accept the certificate because it did not comply with Article 1587 of the R.C.S. 1925.

It is true, the Codifiers changed the method of appointment of Surveyors to run out boundary lines and required the notes and map to be returned to the County Court, however, all matters pertaining to Roads, County line Boundaries, School District Boundaries, in fact, all boundary lines, are subject matter for the Commissioners Court and are recorded in the Minutes of the Commissioners Court.

Under the Statutes, I am Clerk of the County Court and Ex Officio Clerk of the Commissioners Court and following the Statutes as closely as I can interpret them, I made my certificate to comply with all acts of the Legislature in connection with my official position. If I acted as "County Clerk and Clerk of the County Court," I so signify by my certificate, on the other hand, if by reason of recording these proceedings in the Minutes of the Commissioners Court I acted as "Ex Officio Clerk of the Commissioners Court," I so signified by signing the certificate as "Ex Officio Clerk of the Commissioners Court."

Regardless of the Statute, as a matter of common sense and public convenience, I would not, as Clerk of the County Court place these proceedings and map in the Civil Minutes of the County where they would be lost forever so far as the public is concerned, because no one would ever look among Civil Minutes for orders that properly belong in the Minutes of the Commissioners Court.

Again all this character of work is pecuniarily cared for as an ex officio that is allowed me by the Commissioners' Court. Otherwise I could not receive any compensation for the work.
