Field notes of the boundaries lines
of the County of Trinity

Beginning at the S E Corner of Houston County on the West
bank of the Neches River at a Spanish Oak 36 in Di Mhd
C.I. from which a Michory Mhd C.I. is S 83° W 5 Vars and
a White Oak 36 in Di Mhd C.I. is S 12° W 12 1/2 distant
Thence down with the Neches River to the line dividing Trinity
from Tyler Counties on the West bank of said River in Swamy,
and overflowing land to a Water Oak Mhd C.I. Thence South
68° W at 12,280 Vars intersect the N E Corner of Polk County
and N W Corner of Tyler County, Thence same Course with the
line dividing Polk from Trinity Counties 3 1/2 miles in all from the
Neches to the East bank of the Trinity River nearly 4 1/2 miles
running through the league Surveyed in the name of Peter Blanchett
and Crossing the Corner dividing the two Surveys on the West
bank of said River made in the name of J. Trator in Walker County
and J. A. McGoy in Polk County. Thence up Trinity River East
bank to the S W Corner of Houston County and S E Corner of
a Survey made in the name of Henry Goldmans of 980 acres
Thence North 51 1/2° E at 5,060 Vars Dillards Creek at 10,900 Vars Cincinnati
Road at 16,270 Whites Road, at 27,800 Vars Carter-Cox Creek at 34,260
= Big White Rock C at 26 miles N W Corner of J. S. Ward's league, through
Tyler and East Prairies between M^cCarties and Daily's Houses at 64,050
Big Piney Creek 84,400 Vars Hickone Creek and to Beginning 48 1/2 miles
