Trinity County } Field notes of the boundary lines
of the County of Trinity

Beginning at the S E Corner of Houston County on the West bank of the Neches River at a Spanish Oak 86 in Di Mhd CL, from which a Hickory Mhd CL ls S 83° W 5 acres and a White Oak 86 in Di Mhd CL, ls S 12° W 12 1/2 acres distant

Hence down with the Neches River to the line dividing Trinity from Tyler Counties on the West bank of said River in Trinity, and overflowing land to a Water Oak Mhd CL, Hence South 68° W at 12,280 acres intersect the N E Corner of Polk County and N W Corner of Tyler County, Hence same course with the line dividing Polk from Trinity Counties 84 1/2 miles in all from the Neches to the East bank of the Trinity River nearly 41 miles running through the Leagues Surveyed in the name of Peter Blanchard and Crossing the corner dividing the two surveys on the West bank of said River made in the name of Frater in Walker County and Fr A McGroarty in Polk County. Hence up Trinity River East bank to the S W Corner of Houston County and S E corner of a Survey made in the name of Henry Goldmans of 980 acres

Hence North 51 1/2° E at 5.060 1/2 Dillards Creek at 10,900 ft Cincinnati road at 16,270 White Road, at 27,800 ft Tenter Creek at 34,260 = Big White Rock C at 26 miles N W corner of J S Ward's League, through Tyler and East Prairies between McCarties and Daily Houses at 64,050 big Piney Creek 84,400 ft Hockne Creek and to Beginning 48 3/4 miles
