The State of Texas<sup>3</sup> On this the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of  
Tyler County 3 February 1854. in accordance with  
an Order of appointment. of the County Court.  
Within and for Tyler County. I Repaired to the  
the mouth of Piney Creek on the west bank of the  
Neche River in order to Run and mark the Dis-  
trict line between the Counties of Tyler Trinity  
and Polk. and to establish the corners of said Tyler  
County.

Beginning at the mouth of said Piney Creek  
on the East bank of the Neche river. from which the  
South west corner of a 320 acre Survey made for Anderson  
Barclay. bears S $\frac{1}{8}$ ° W. 4980. varas. A Black gum tree  
bears N $30^{\circ}$  E. 6 varas —

Hence S $57^{\circ}$  W. with the south line of Trinity  
County. at 10 varas said Piney Creek 16 varas wide  
at 428 varas same at 520 varas same. at 12350.  
Twelve thousand three hundred and fifty varas to  
the North East corner of Polk County. from which  
the Southwest corner of a 320 acre Survey made  
for Anderson Barclay bears N $73^{\circ}$  E. 8798 varas —

Hence South W $11^{\circ}$  East. at 8.060. varas crossed  
Caney Creek 100s wide at 9290 varas crossed the  
road leading from Peachtree village to Moscow. at  
18470 varas crossed the line South line of a 5 League  
Survey made for Peter E Bean 673 varas west of the  
N E Corner of a 320 acre Survey made for F G Waring  
32500. varas the road from fenced in Village to  
Smithfield. 34500. varas road from Woodville to  
Livingston. 36100. varas Branch runs S.E. at 47240.  
varas Wood's creek. 48100 varas to the South line of Wash  
Tevis' Western Survey. 48920 varas road from Woodville to  
Smithfield

at 57260 varas School creek, over which runs S.E. 610 A.D.O.  
varas Road. at 65300 varas Big Sandy or village crk.  
a White Oak 7 inches in diameter marked "Tyer 8<sup>th</sup>" from  
which a Pin Oak 10 in diameter W.R.d & bears S78° E. 8 varas -  
and the South west corner of Richard Santibany  
of 6000 acros. bears Nortw 42° 30' E. 6846 varas -  
closed. On the 17<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1855.
