WILLIAMS

The State of Texas³ On this the 1st Monday of
Tyler County³ February 1854 in accordance with
an Order of appointment of the County Court
within and for Tyler County. I repaired to the
mouth of Piney Creek on the west bank of the
Neche River in order to run and mark the dry line
between the Counties of Tyler, Trinity
and Polk, and to establish the corners of said Tyler
County.

Beginning at the mouth of said Piney Creek
on the East bank of the Neche river from which the
South west corner of a 320 acre Survey made for Anderson
Barclay bears $S 18^{\circ} W$. 4980. Varas. a Black gum tree
bears $N 30^{\circ} E$. 6000 Varas.

Thence $S 57^{\circ} W$. with the South line of Trinity
County. at 10000 Varas said Piney Creek 16000 Varas wide
at 4200 Varas same at 5200 Varas same. at 12350.
Twelve thousand three hundred and fifty Varas to
the North East corner of Polk County. from which
the South west corner of a 320 acre Survey made
for Anderson Barclay bears $N 73^{\circ} E$. 8790 Varas.

Thence South 11° East. at 8060. Varas crossed
Cane Creek 1000 wide at 9290 Varas crossed the
Road leading from Peachtree Village to Moscow. at
18470 Varas crossed the true South line of a 5 League
Survey made for Peter E Bean 673 Varas west of the
N E Corner of a 320 acre Survey made for F G Warring
32500. Varas the road from fenced in Village to
Smithfield. 34500. Varas road from Woodville to
Livingston. 36100. Varas Branch runs S E. at 47240.
000 Varas Woods' Creek. 48100 Varas to the South line of Wash
Levis' Western Survey. 4892000 Varas Road from Woodville to
Smithfield

at 57260 varas School creek 10 varas wide runs S.E. 61/240.
 varas Road. at 65300 varas Big Sandy or village etc.
 a white oak 7 inches in diameter marked "Tyler Co." from
 which a Pine oak 10 in diameter WRD & bears S 78° E. 8 varas
 and the South west corner of Richard Smith's survey
 of 640 Acres bears North 49 1/2° West and East 8 1/2° North
 closed. On the 17th day of November 1855
