

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Commissioners Court of Upton County, Texas, held on November 14th, 1927, the said Court ordered a re-survey of the boundary line between Crane and Upton Counties, and an agreement was made between Crane County and Upton County to employ J. J. Goodfellow, a state surveyor, to re-survey and re-trace the aforesaid line as surveyed by R. W. Cushman and J. R. Wordsworth in February, 1911; and

WHEREAS, the said J. J. Goodfellow did make said re-survey of the common boundary line between Crane and Upton Counties as directed by the respective Commissioners Court of the said Crane and Upton Counties, and based his work upon such original markings, mounds and corners as he was able to find which were identified as the markings, mounds and corners placed in said line by the said Cushman and Wordsworth in 1911;

AND, after said common boundary line was run out and identified, the said Goodfellow re-marked the entire line by placing a two-inch by five-foot iron pipe at the end of each mile along said line; and

WHEREAS, on May 14th, 1928, after the completion of the said re-survey by said J. J. Goodfellow, and after he had made his report, and after said report had been placed of record in the records of Crane County and Upton County, the Commissioners' Court of Crane County entered the following order in the Minutes of said Court as appears in Volume 1, Page 46 of said Minutes, to-wit:

"It is ordered by the Court that County-line-survey as surveyed by J. J. Goodfellow, surveyor, be approved"; and

WHEREAS, Upton County has not as yet entered an order approving said survey, it was therefore moved by Commissioner Rankin, and seconded by Commissioner Key, that the re-survey of the common boundary line between Crane and Upton Counties, as heretofore made by J. J. Goodfellow, be approved, and that the line as established by the said J. J. Goodfellow Survey be adopted as the common boundary line between Crane and Upton Counties. All Commissioners voting "Aye".
